### **Takeaways**

- As of 2020 the region's population increased by 2.9% since 2015, growing by 1,327. Population is expected to increase by 3.3% between 2020 and 2025, adding 1,561.
- From 2015 to 2020, jobs increased by 2.7% in Monroe County, WI from 22,509 to 23,107. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 1.3% by 1.4%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 63.0% to 62.9% between 2015 and 2020.
- Concerning educational attainment, **14.7% of Monroe County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (5.4% below the national average), and **11.5% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.9% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2020 are Federal Government, Civilian, Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).













## **Population Trends**




### **Job Trends**




## **Unemployment Rate Trends**

#### Millennials


Monroe County, WI has 8,451 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 9,537.


**Veterans** 

Monroe County, WI has 4,524 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 2.569.




#### **Retiring Soon**

Retirement risk is about average in Monroe County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 13,599 people 55 or older, while there are 14,754 here.




#### **Violent Crime**

Racial diversity is low in Monroe County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 18,450 racially diverse people, while there are 4,658 here.




#### **Property Crime**


















#### 2020 Median Hourly Earnings






