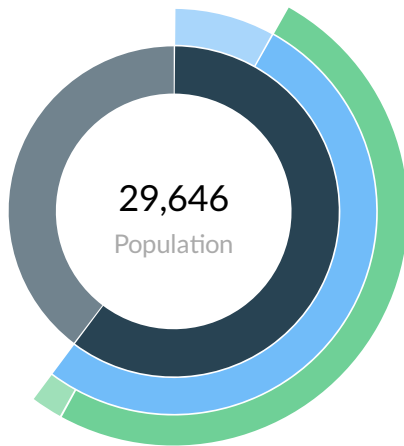
Median household income is **\$4.3K below** the national median household income of \$62.8K.

Takeaways

- As of 2020 the region's population **increased by 0.7%** since 2015, growing by 205. Population is expected to **decrease by 0.6%** between 2020 and 2025, losing 191.
- From 2015 to 2020, jobs **declined by 9.8%** in Trempealeau County, WI from 16,422 to **14,811**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 1.3% by 11.1%**. As the number of jobs declined, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 70.9% to 65.7% between 2015 and 2020**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **14.2% of Trempealeau County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (5.9% below the national average), and **15.0% hold an Associate's Degree** (6.4% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2020 are Household and Institutional Furniture and Kitchen Cabinet Manufacturing, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.

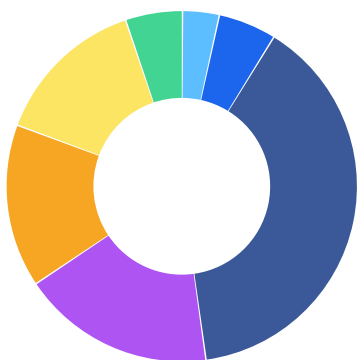

Educational Attainment

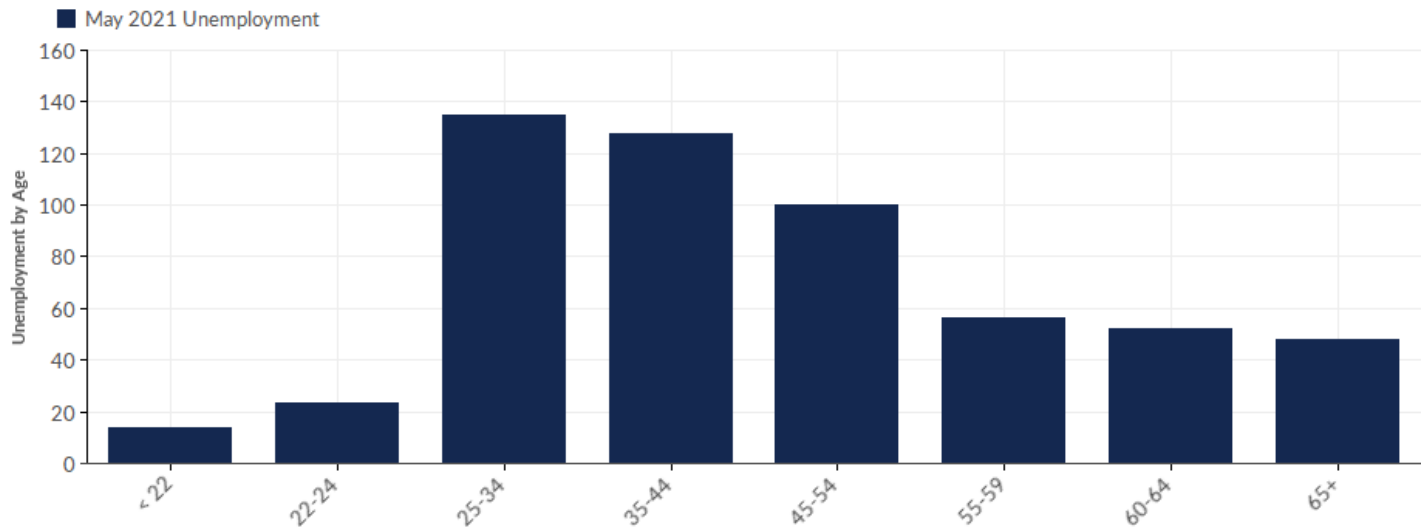

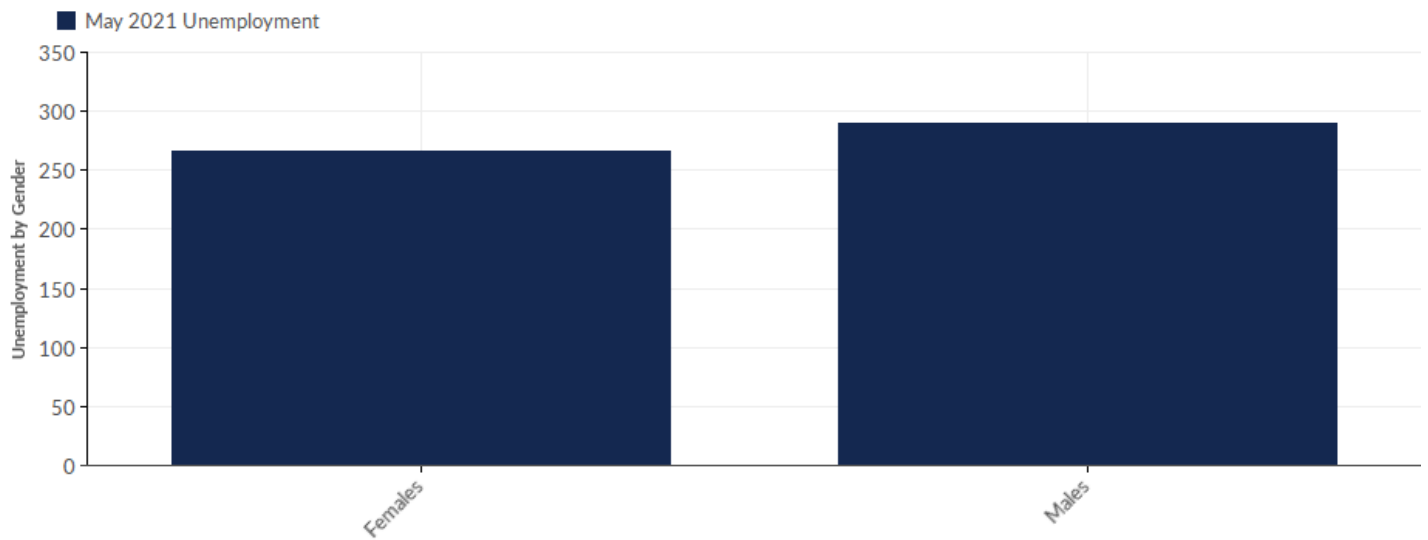

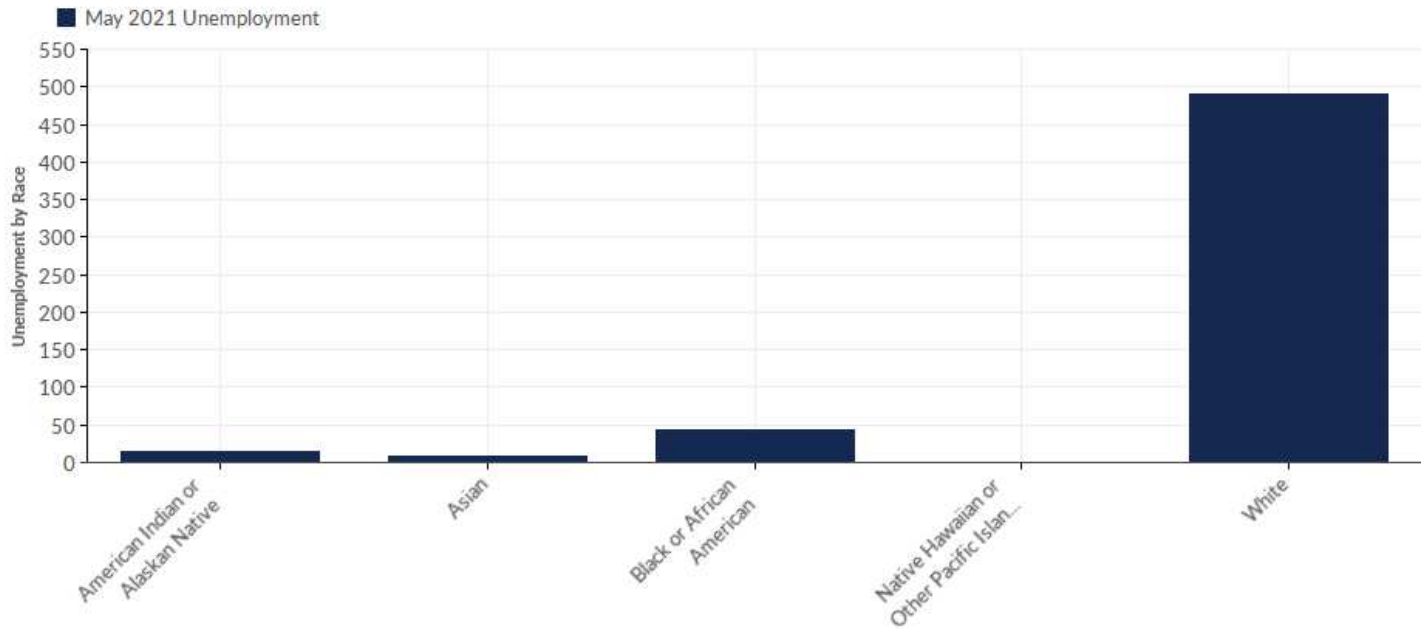

Unemployment by Gender



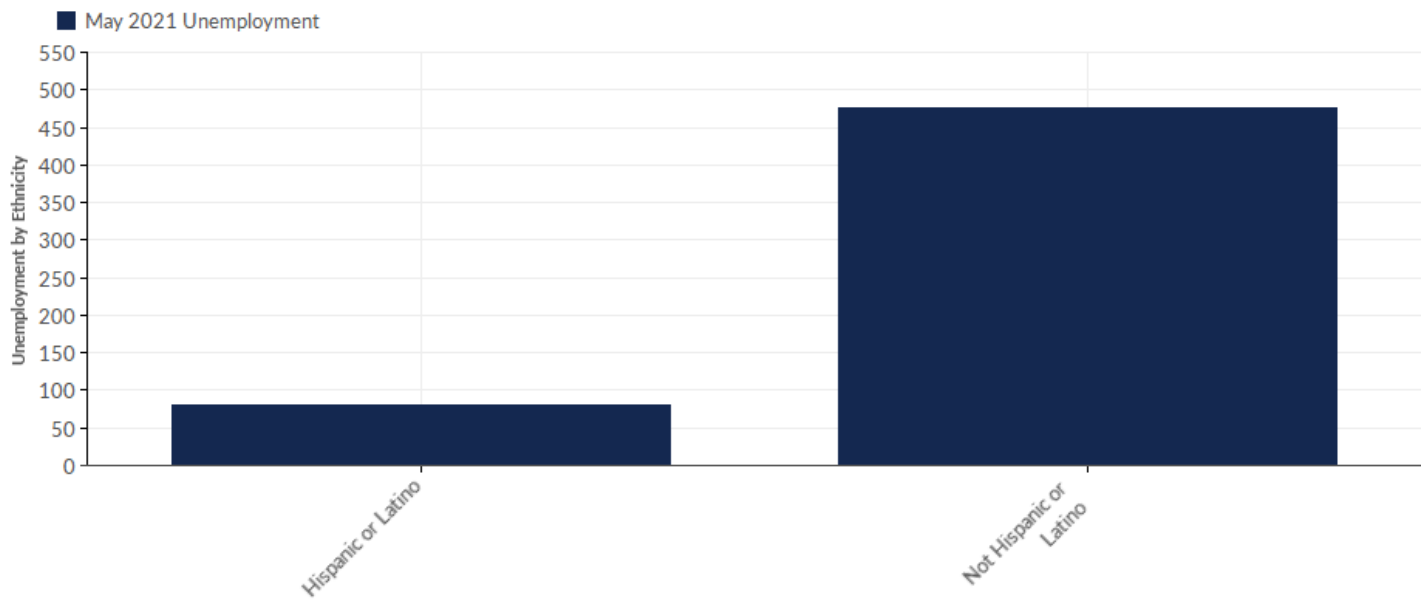

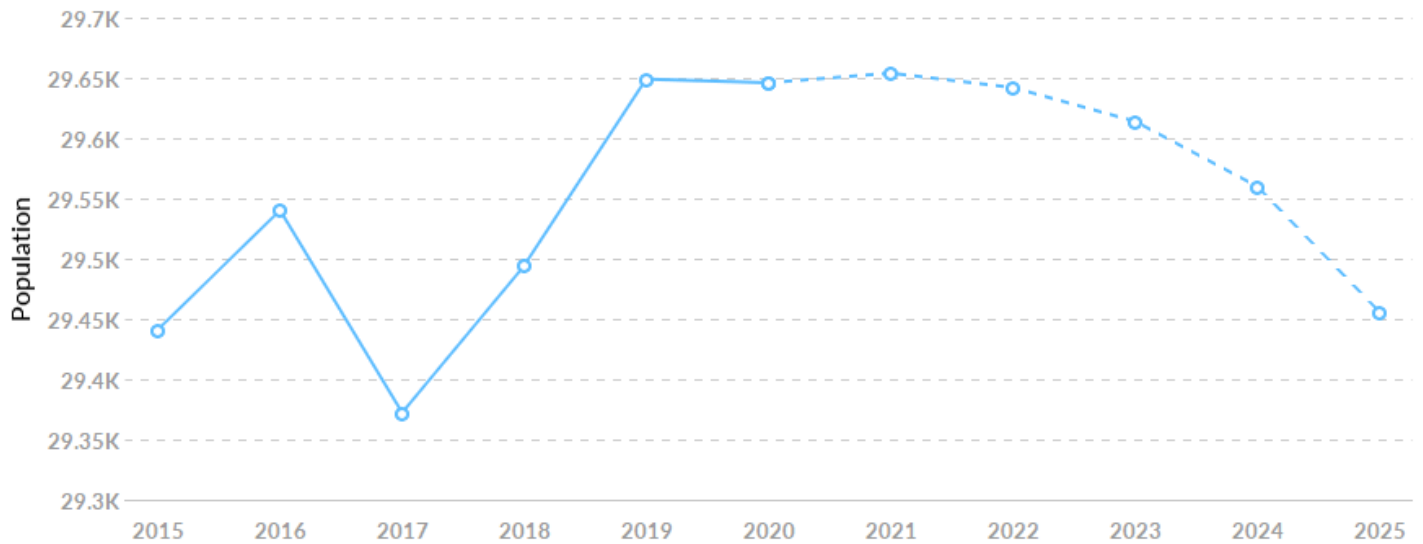

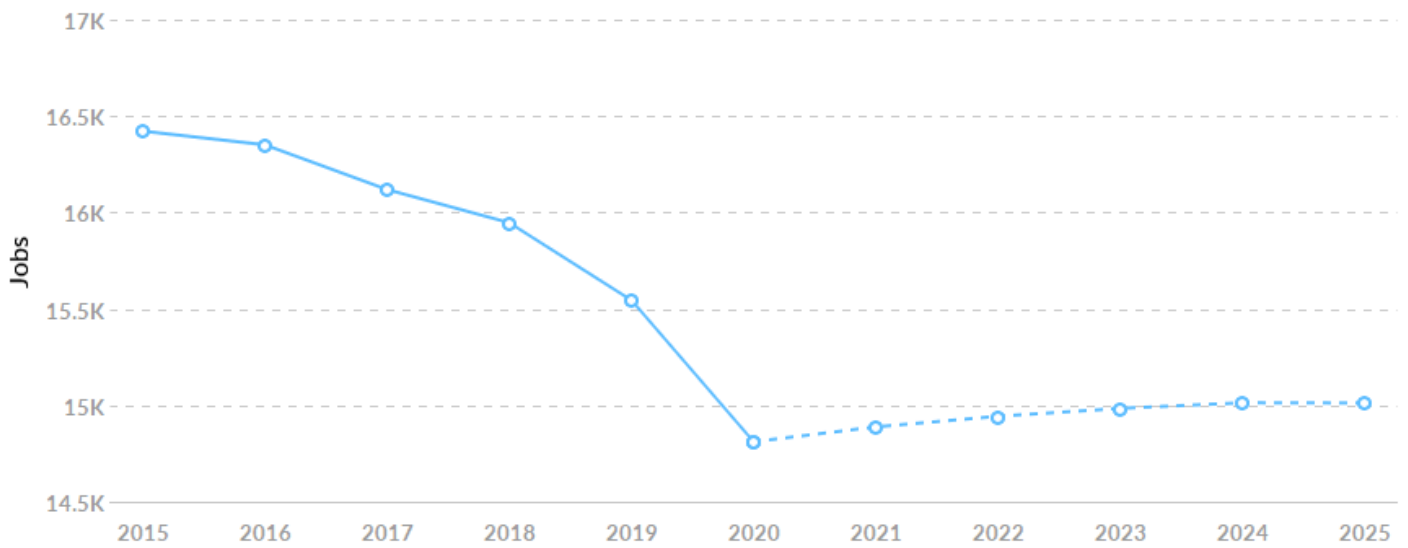

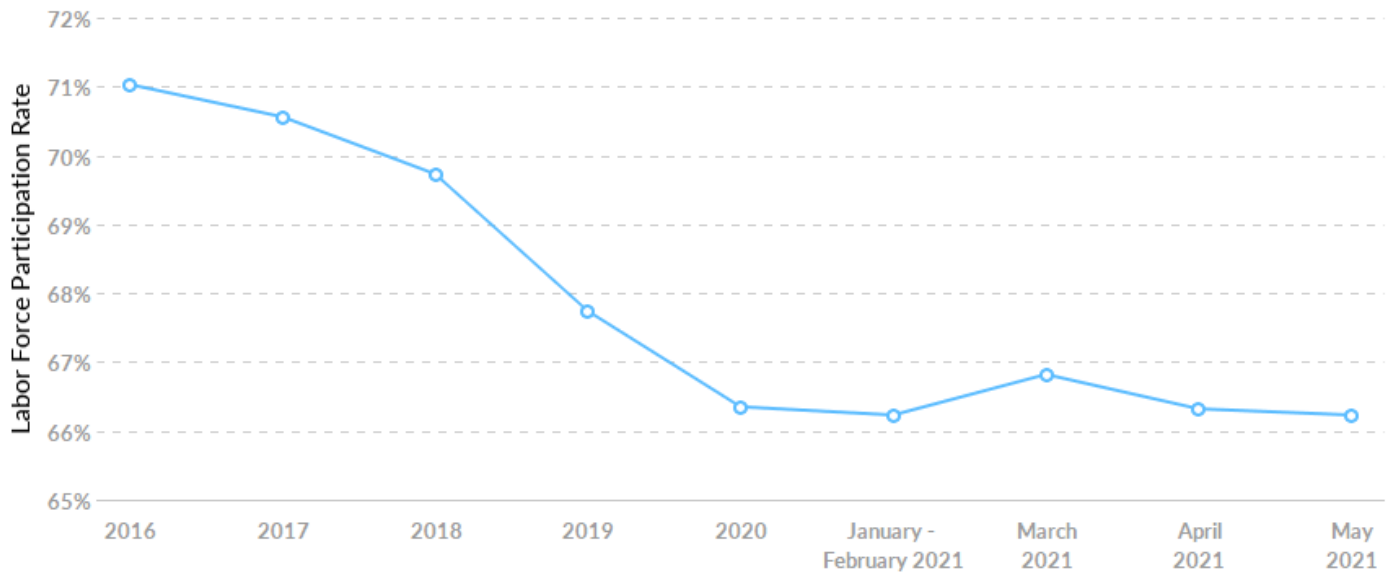
Job Trends

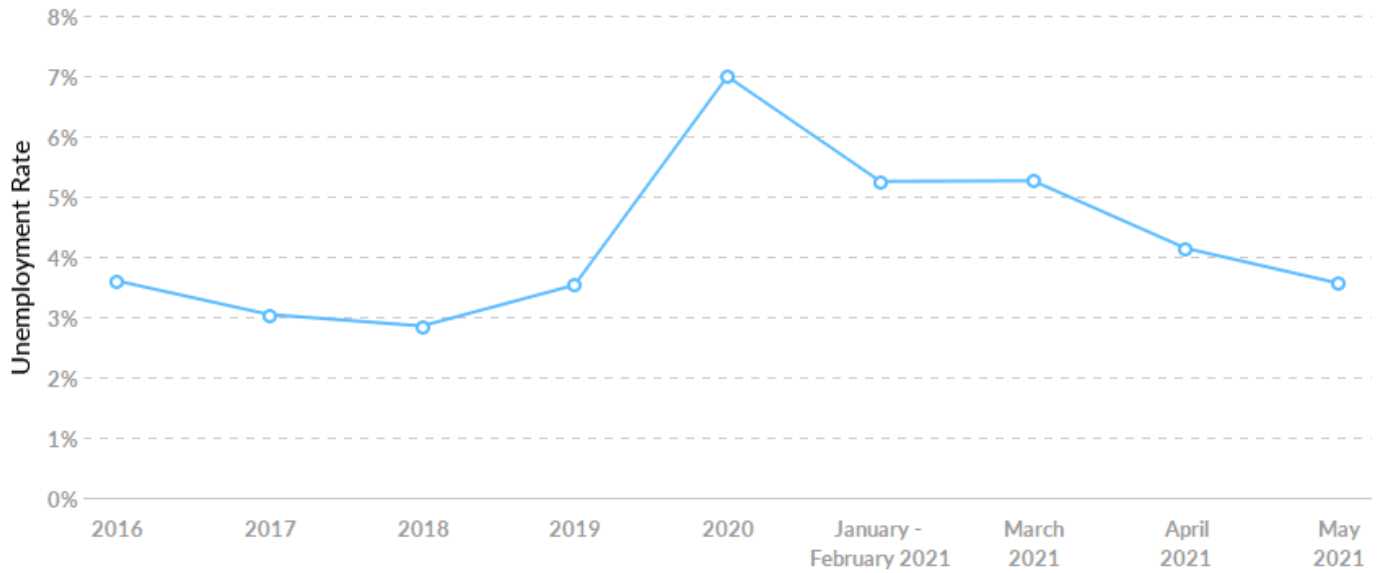

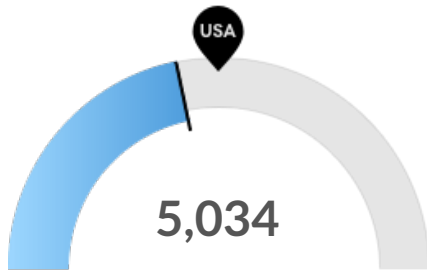
Unemployment Rate Trends

Trempealeau County, WI had a May 2021 unemployment rate of 3.56%, **decreasing from 3.60% 5 years before.**



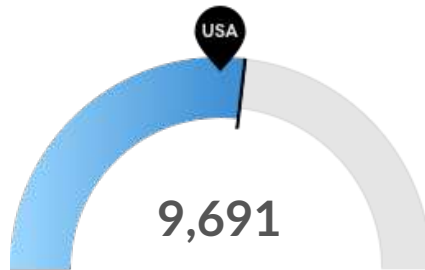

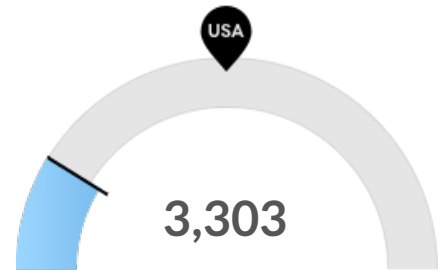
Millennials

Trempealeau County, WI has 5,034 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 6,113.



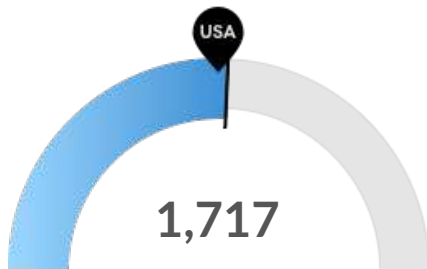
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Trempealeau County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 8,717 people 55 or older, while there are 9,691 here.



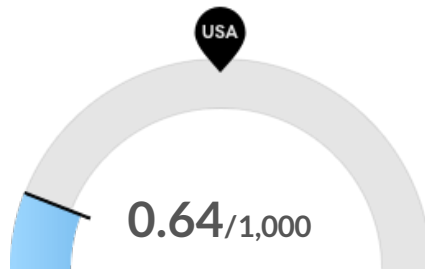
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Trempealeau County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 11,827 racially diverse people, while there are 3,303 here.



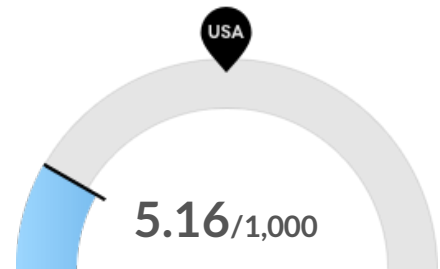
Veterans

Trempealeau County, WI has 0.64 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.53 per 1,000 people.

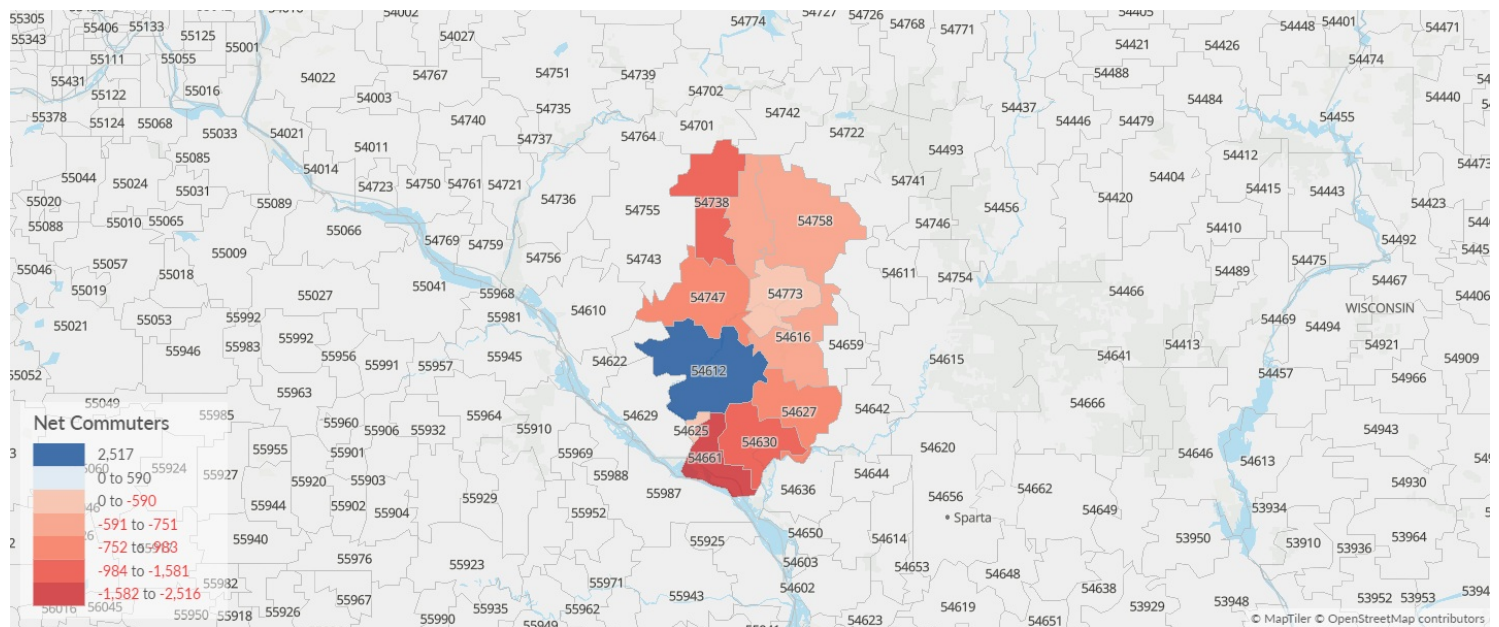


Property Crime

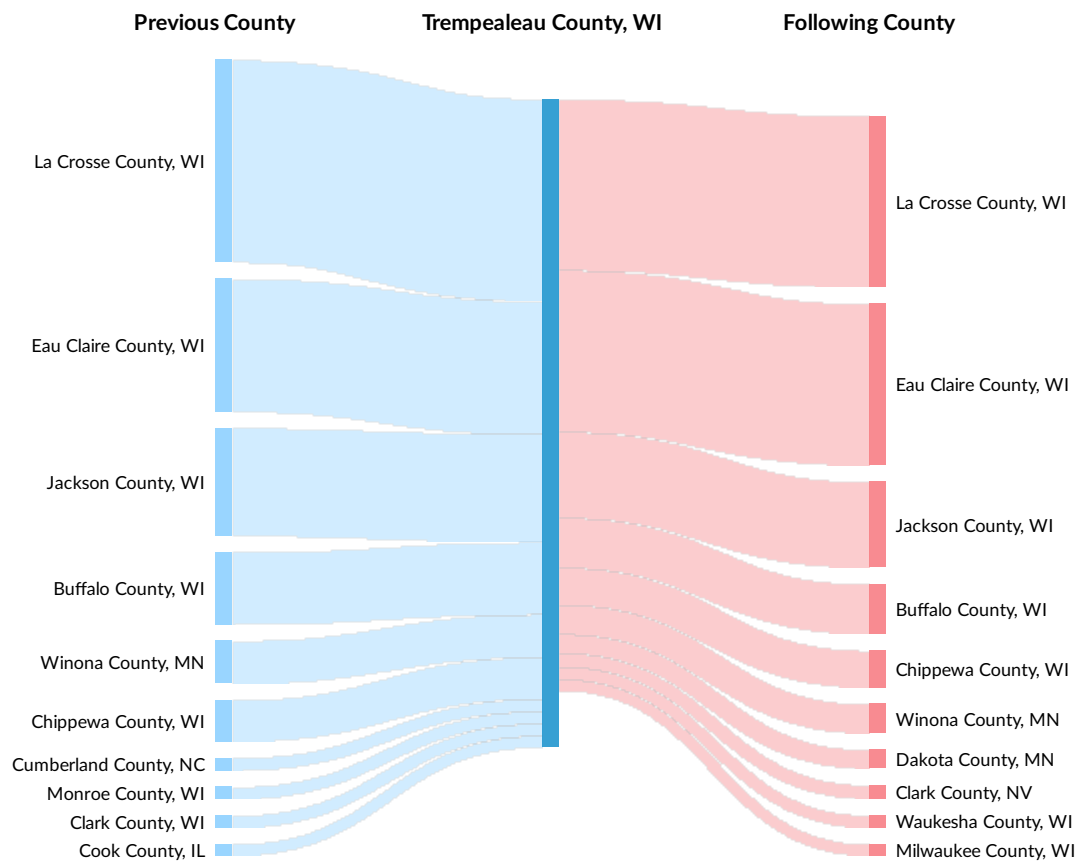

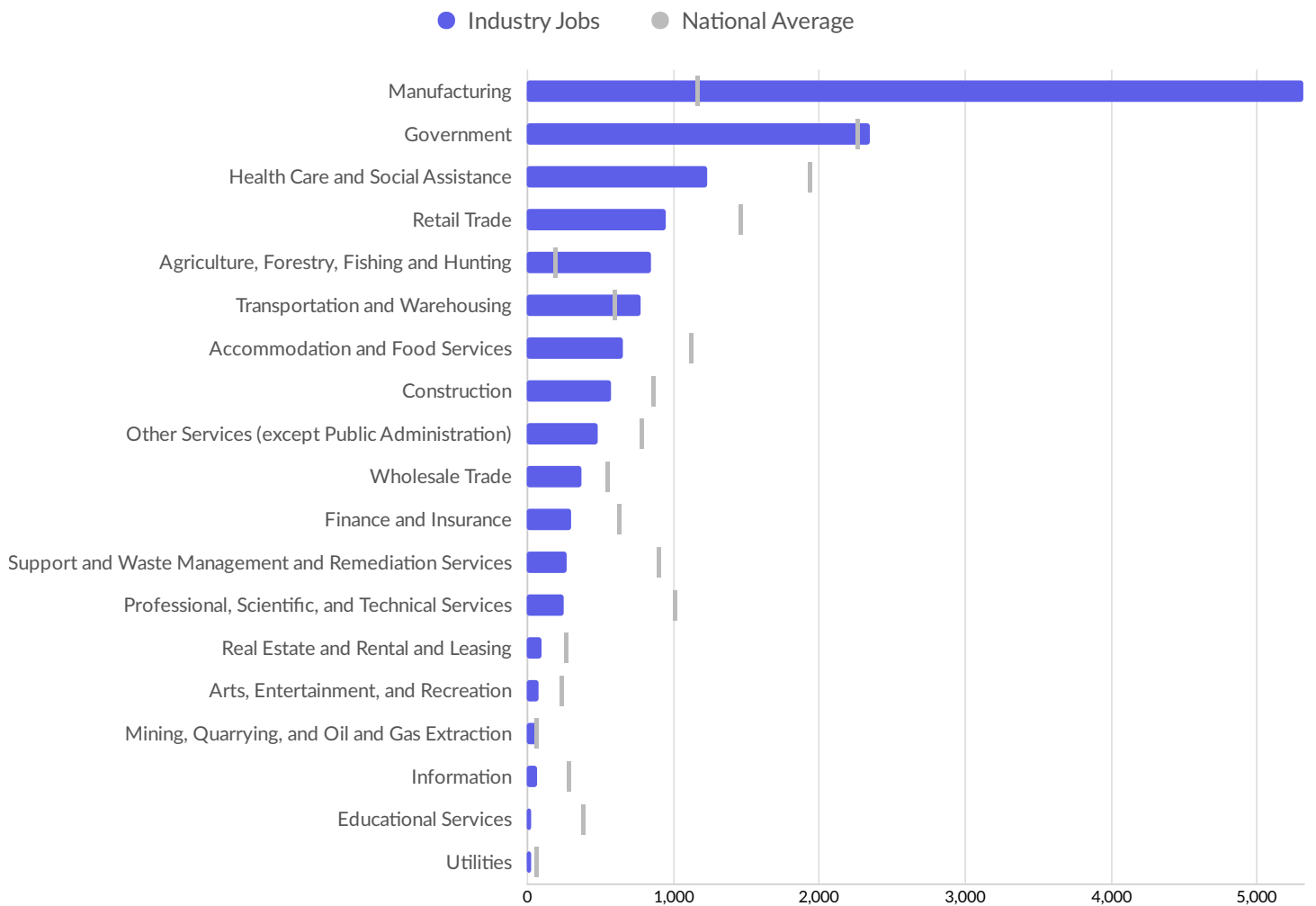

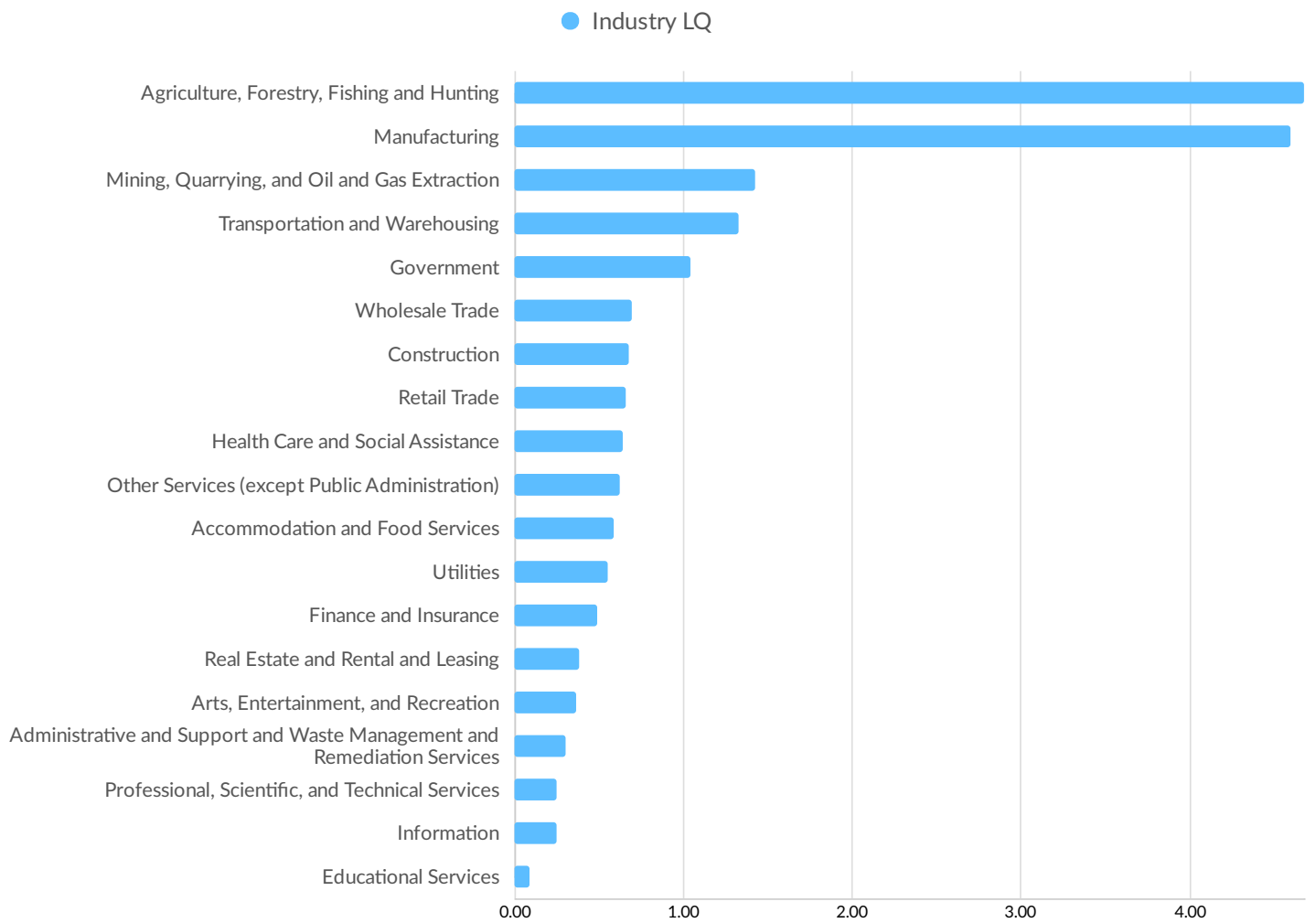

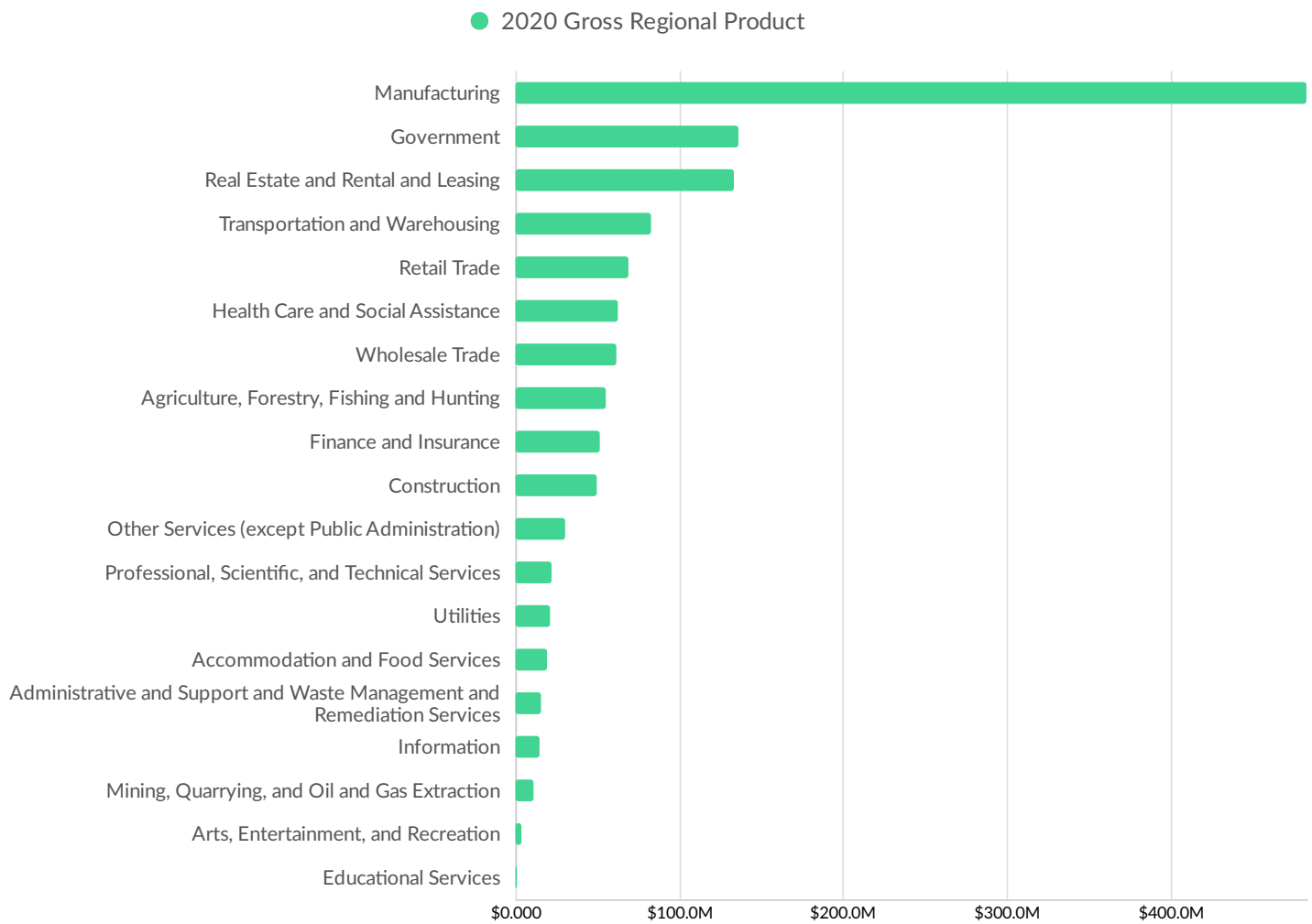

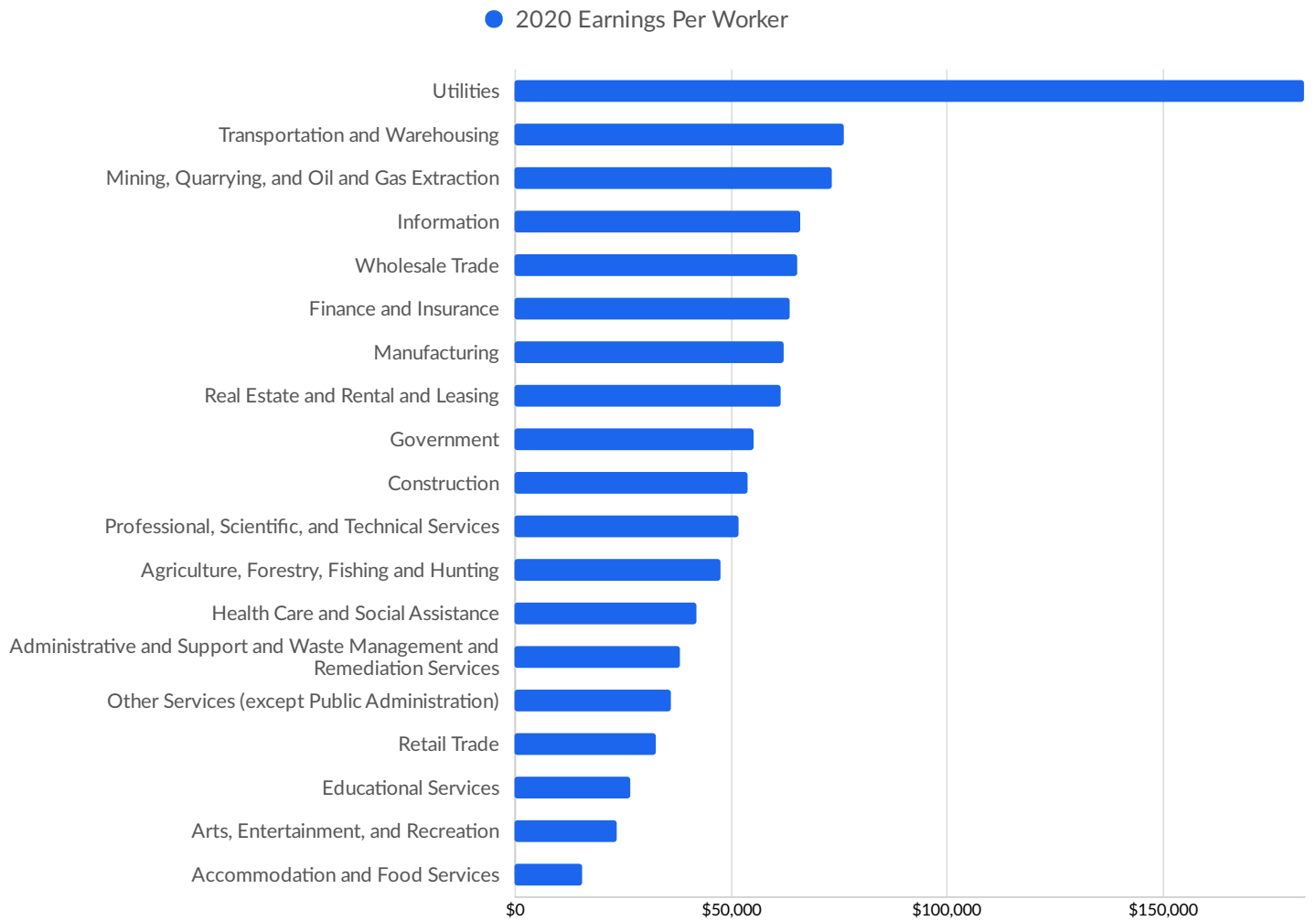

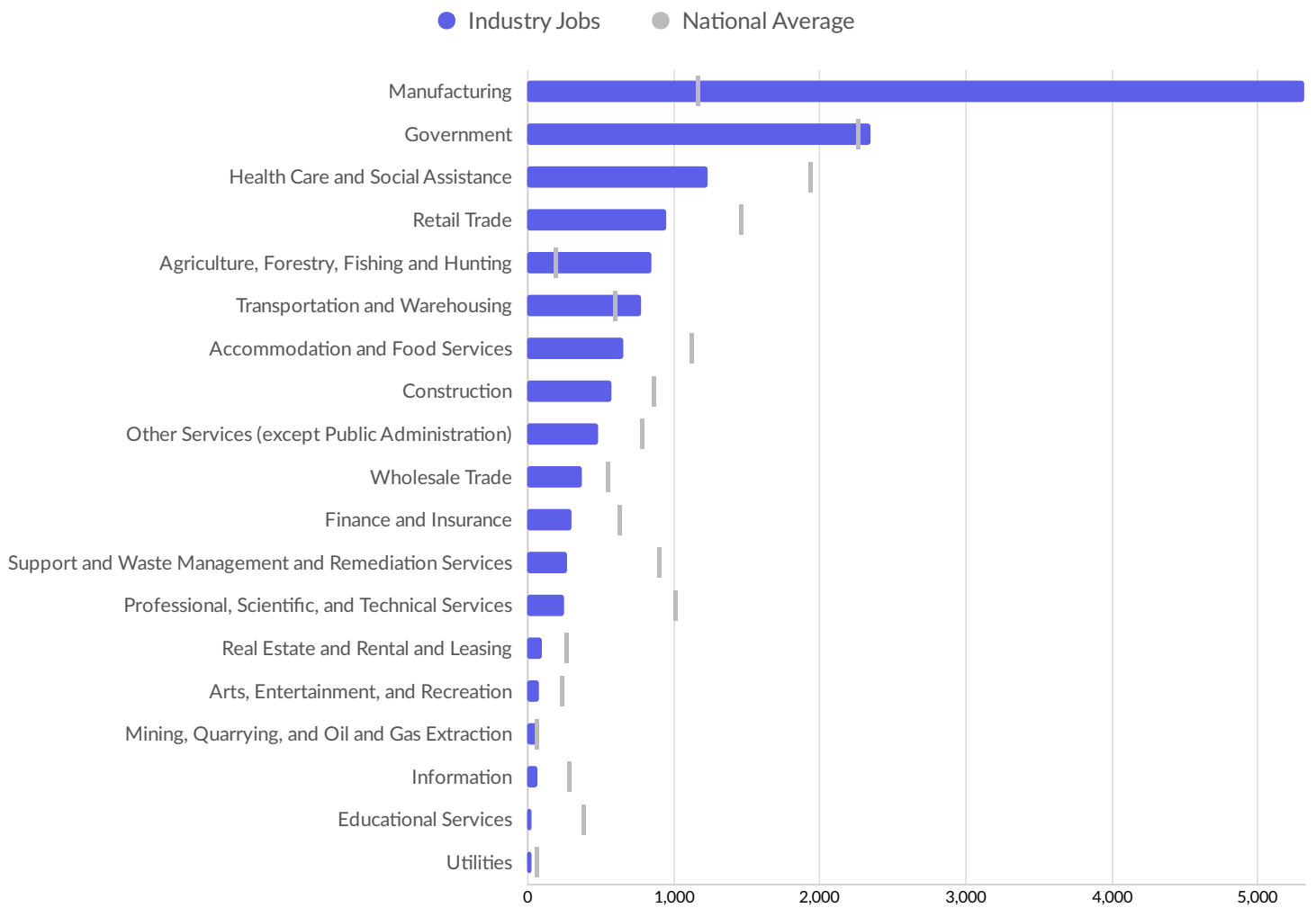

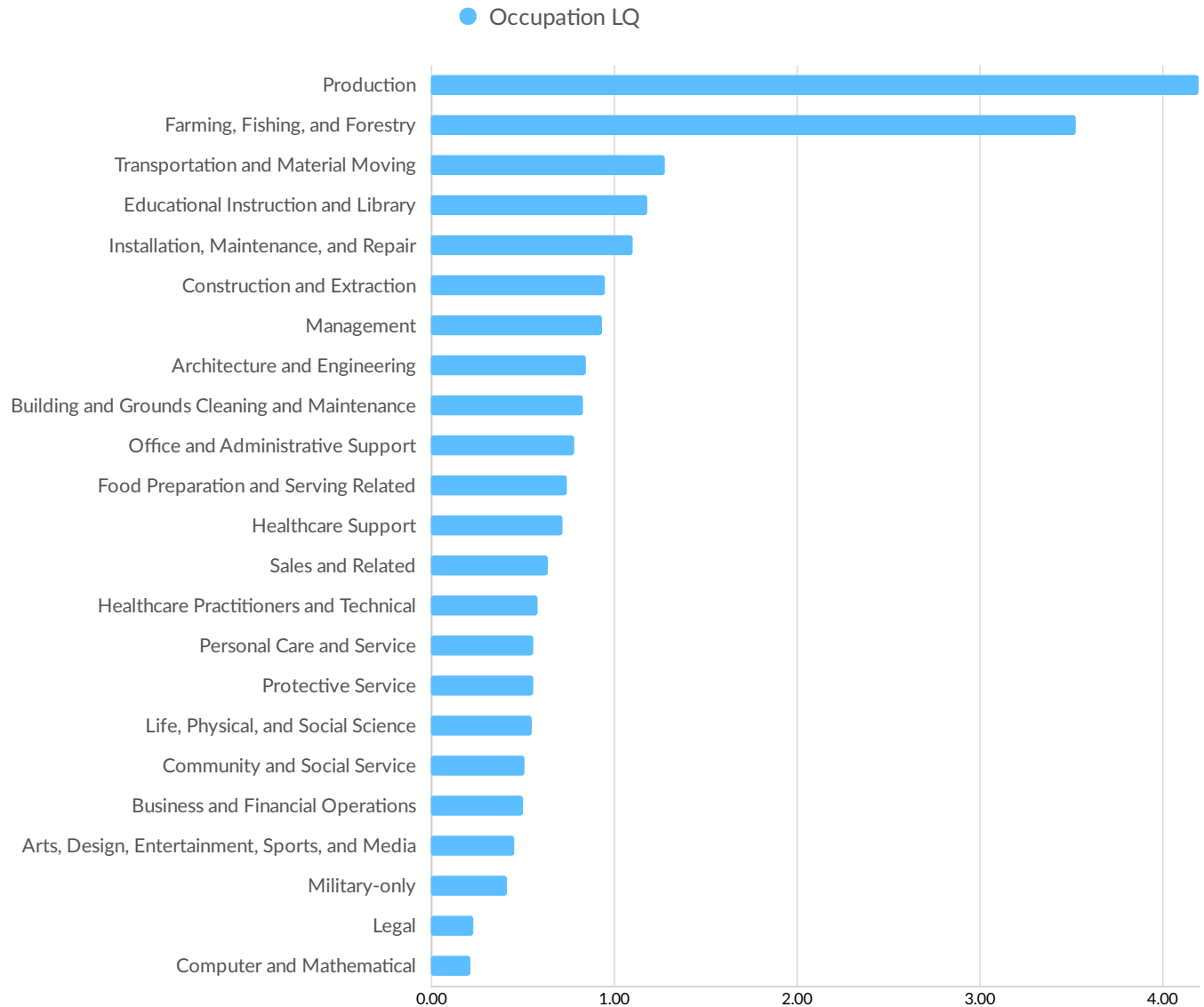

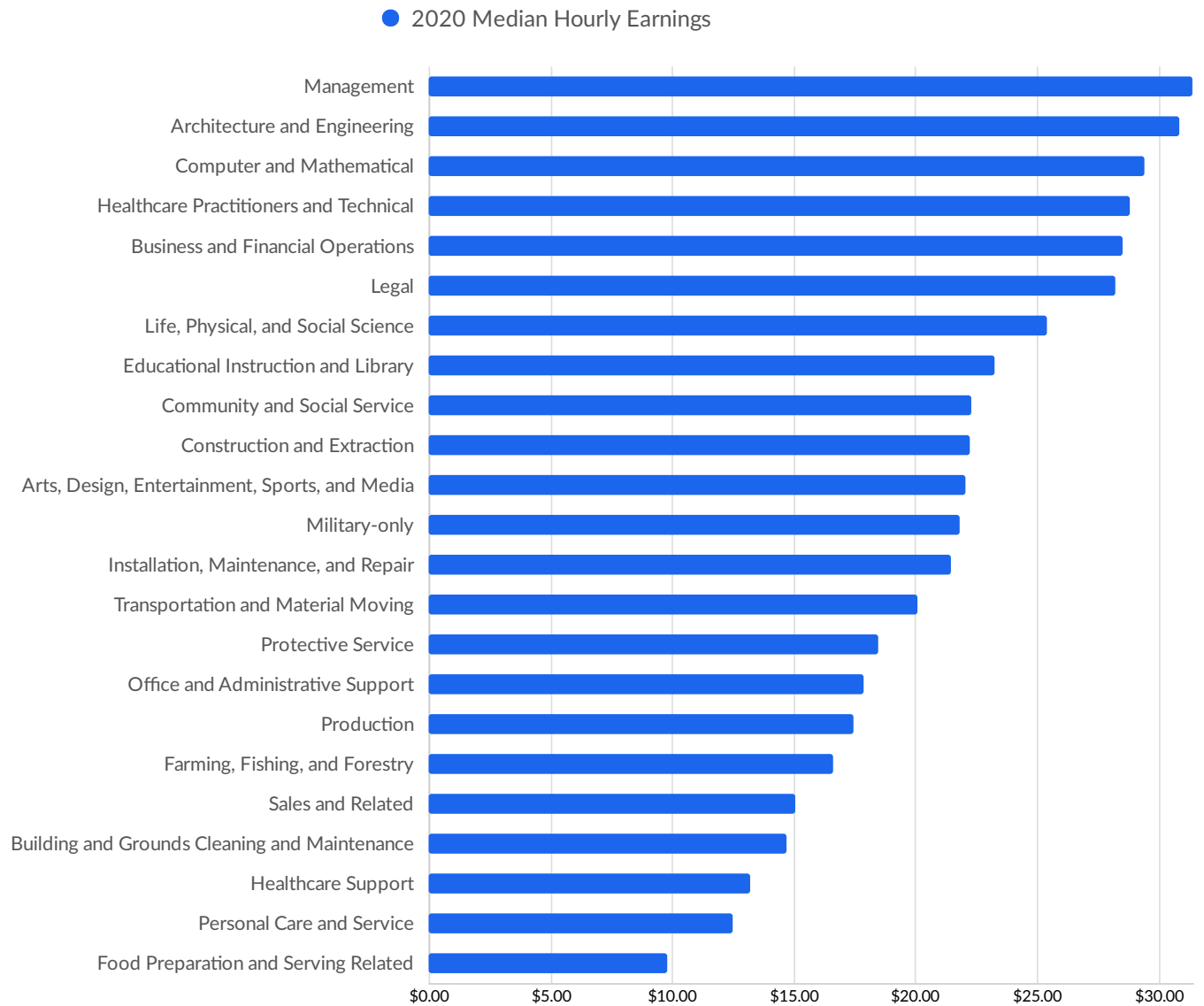
Top Growing Occupations



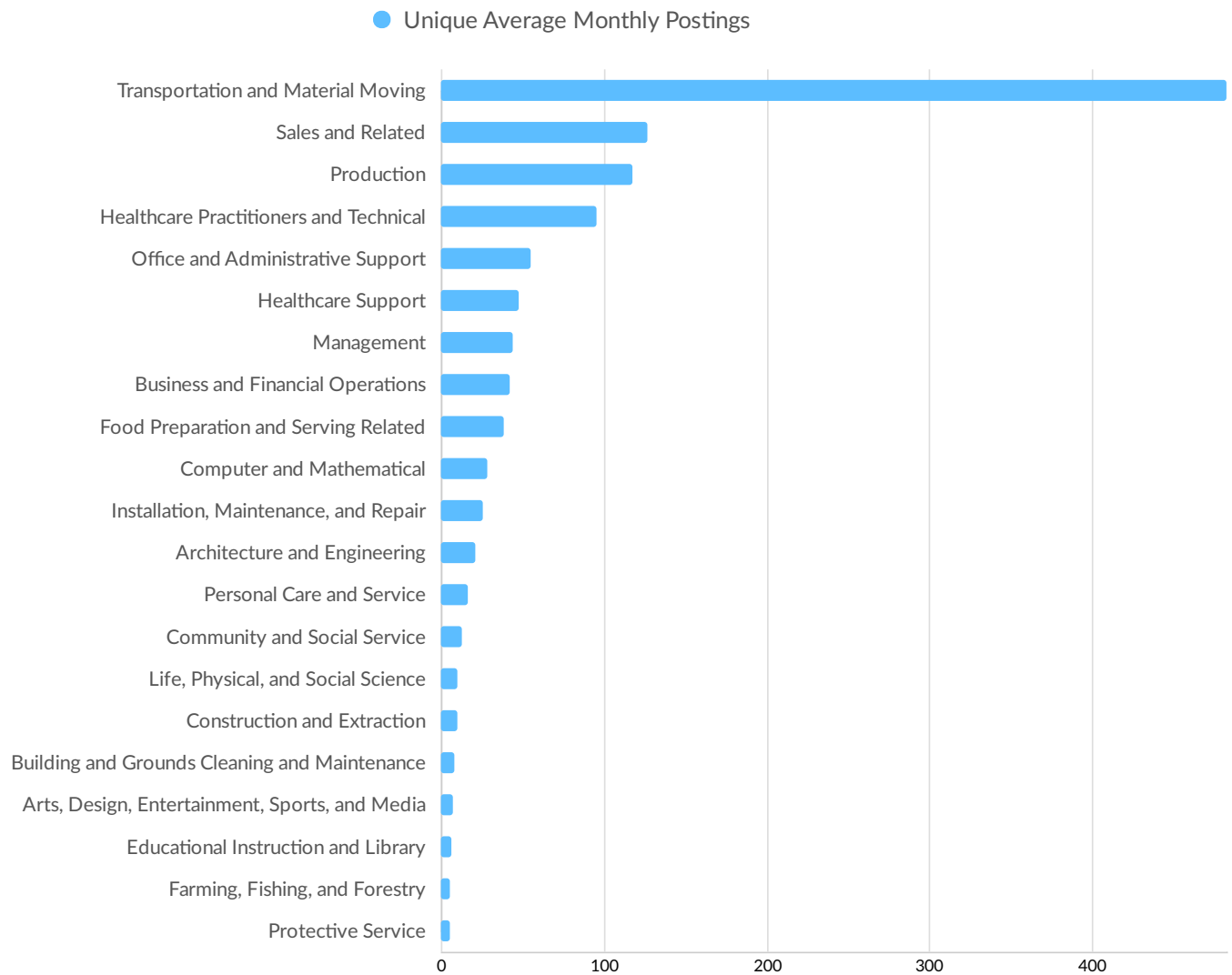

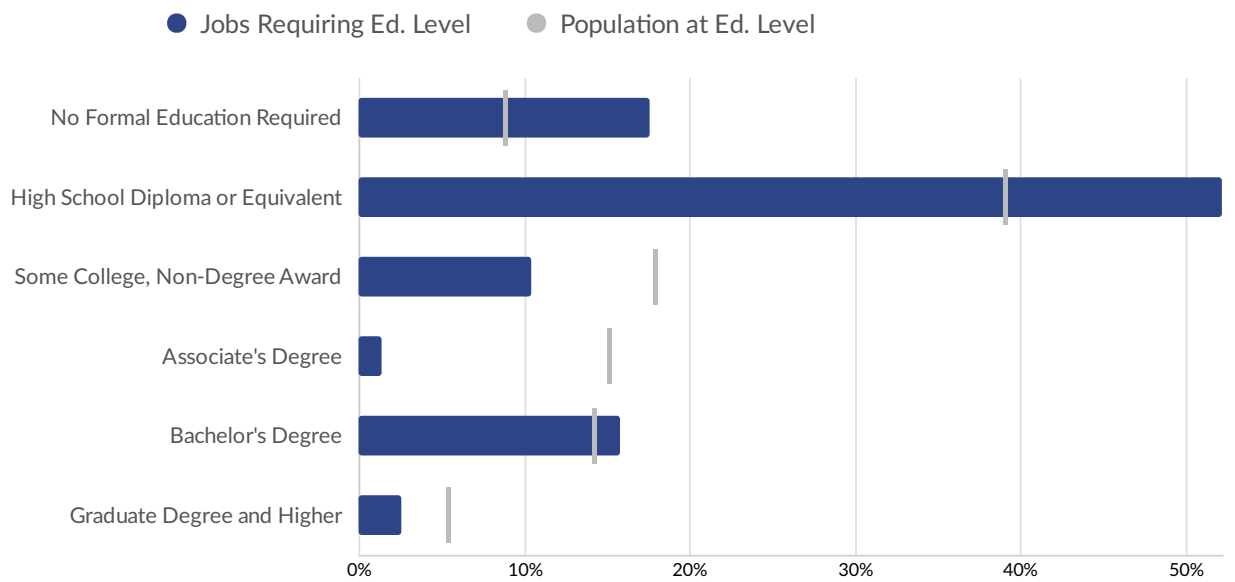

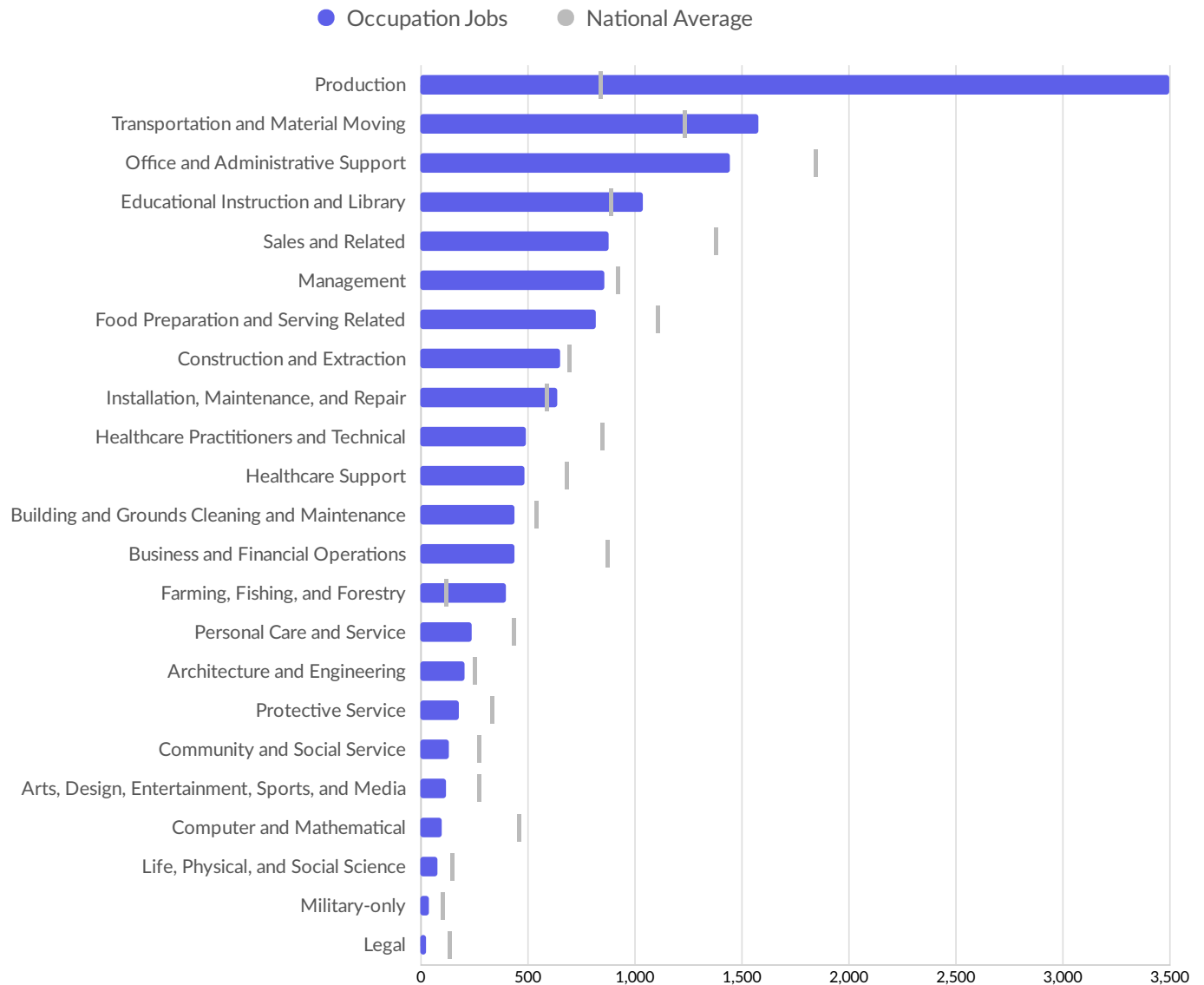
