
Takeaways

- As of 2022 the region's population increased by 2.5% since 2017, growing by 321. Population is expected to increase by 3.8% between 2022 and 2027, adding 506.
- From 2017 to 2022, jobs declined by 0.5% in Buffalo County, WI from 4,616 to 4,595. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.8% by 4.3%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 61.3% to 53.2% between 2017 and 2022.
- Concerning educational attainment, **14.7% of Buffalo County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (6.1% below the national average), and **14.8% hold an Associate's Degree** (5.9% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2022 are General Freight Trucking, Animal Production, and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).










Unemployment by Gender





Unemployment by Ethnicity







Job Trends






Buffalo County, WI had an April 2023 unemployment rate of 3.26%, decreasing from 3.41% 5 years before.



Millennials




Veterans

Buffalo County, WI has 868 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 699.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Buffalo County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 3,954 people 55 or older, while there are 5,214 here.




Violent Crime

Racial diversity is low in Buffalo County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 5,413 racially diverse people, while there are 669 here.




Property Crime










Top Industry Employment Concentration








Top Growing Occupations






Top Occupation Employment Concentration










