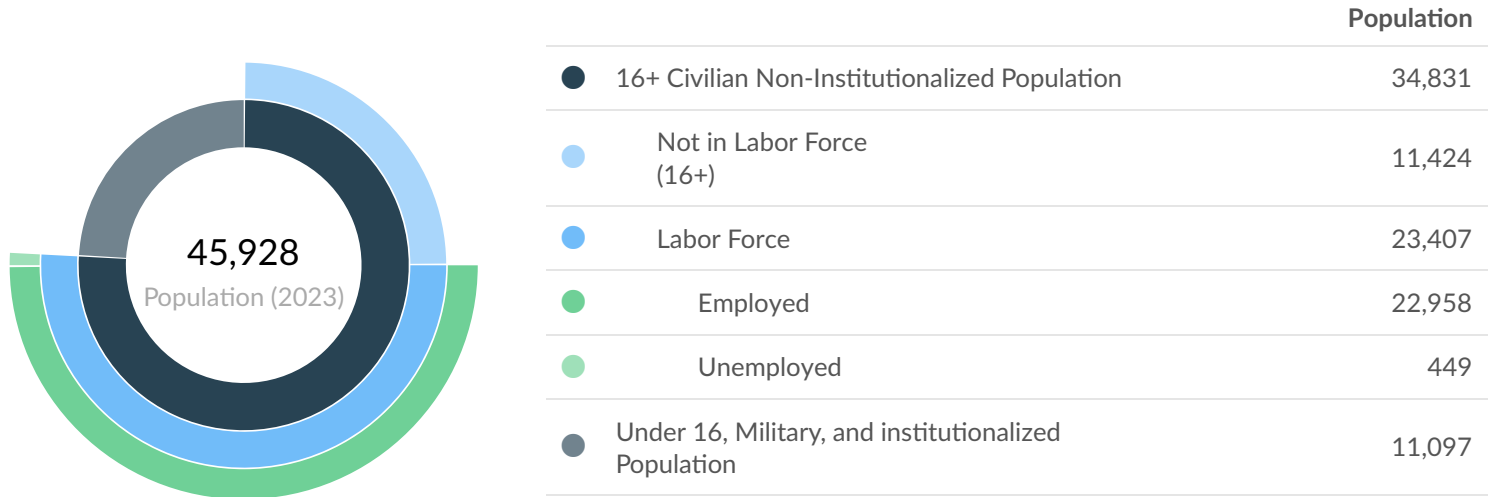
Median household income is **\$6.0K below** the national median household income of \$69.0K.

Takeaways

- As of 2022 the region's population **increased by 0.6%** since 2017, growing by 267. Population is expected to **decrease by 1.8%** between 2022 and 2027, losing 817.
- From 2017 to 2022, jobs **increased by 0.6%** in Monroe County, WI from 23,236 to **23,385**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 3.8% by 3.2%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 67.0% to 64.8% between 2017 and 2022**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **14.4% of Monroe County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (6.4% below the national average), and **12.2% hold an Associate's Degree** (3.4% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2022 are Federal Government, Civilian, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.

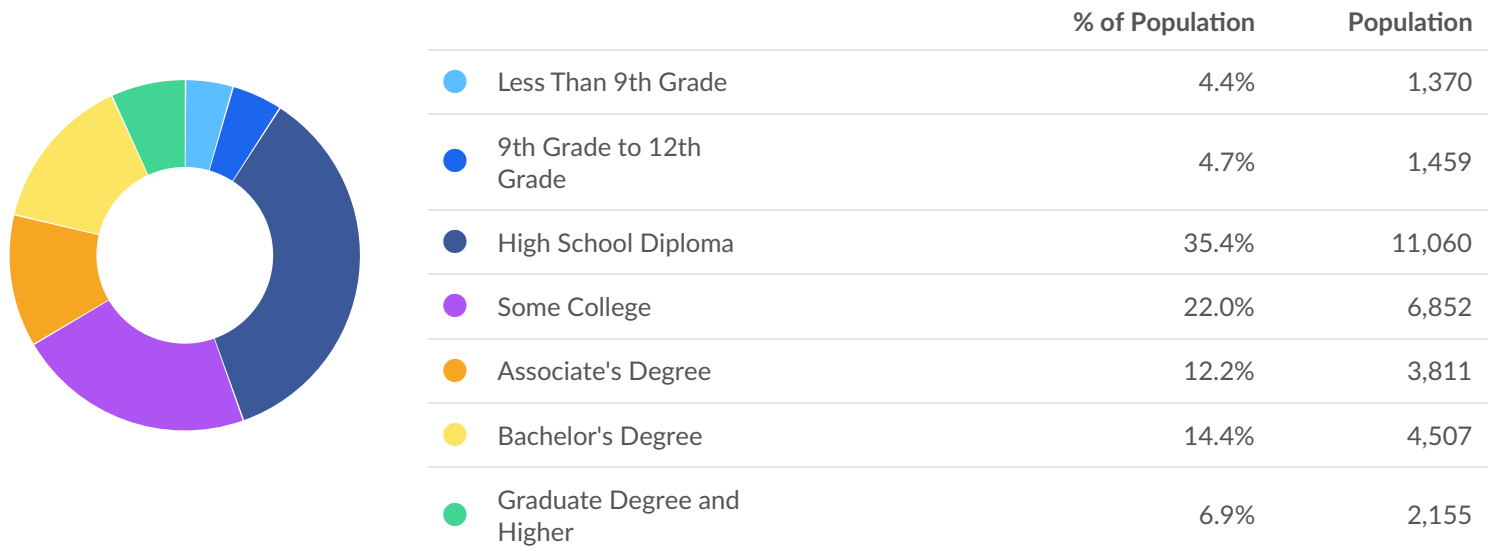

Apr 2023 Labor Force Breakdown



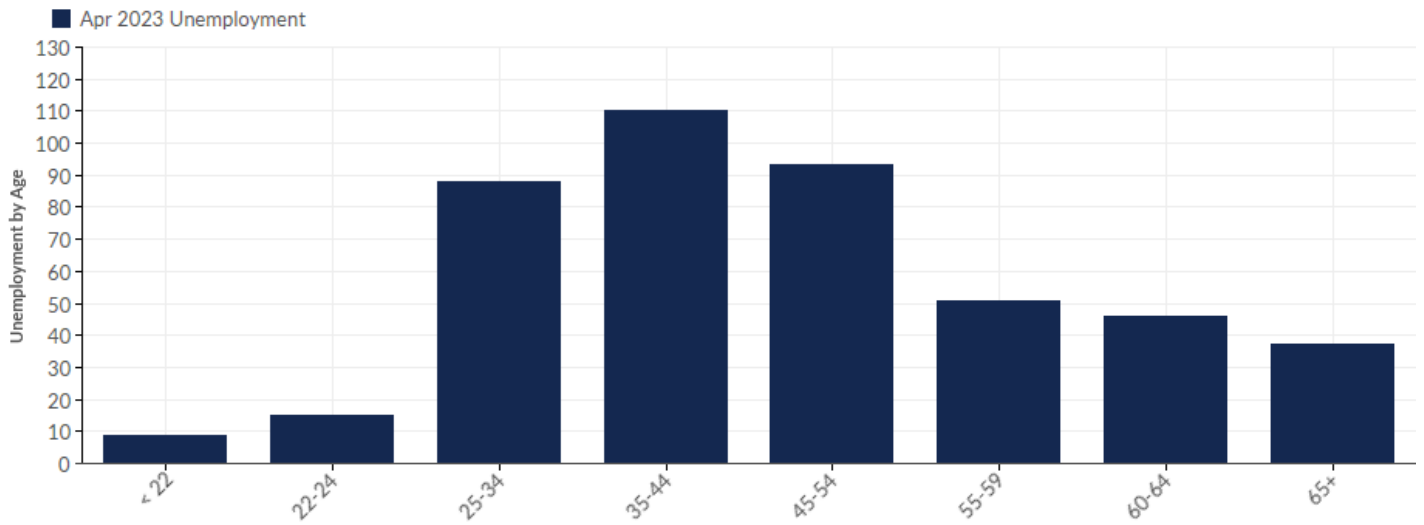
Educational Attainment

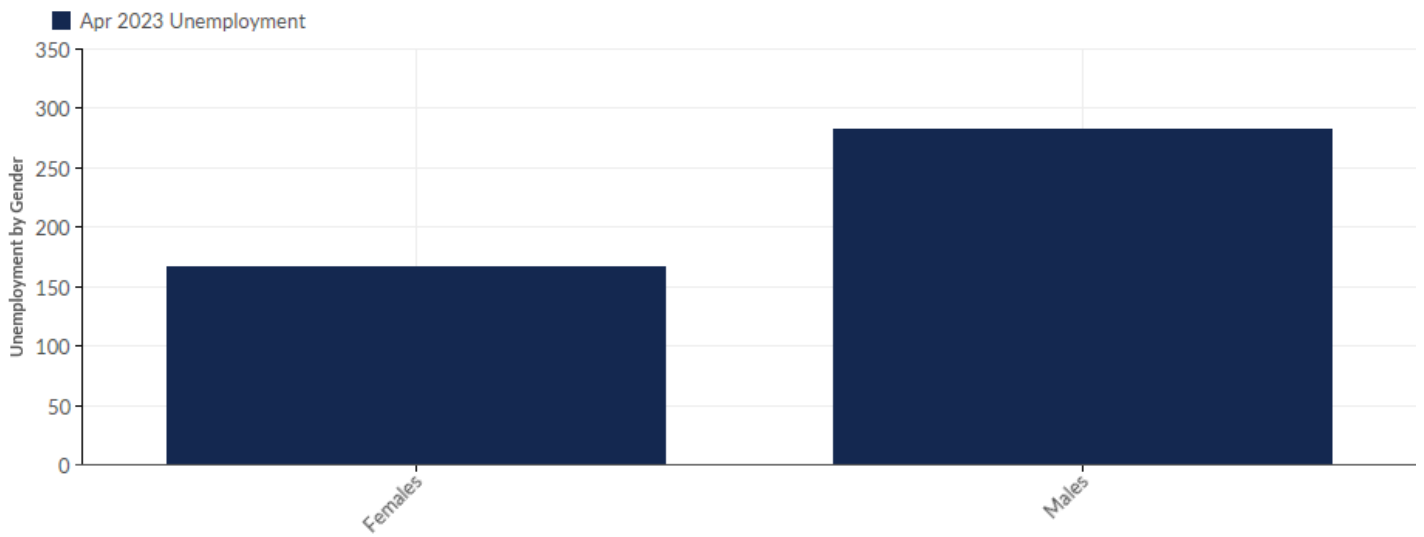

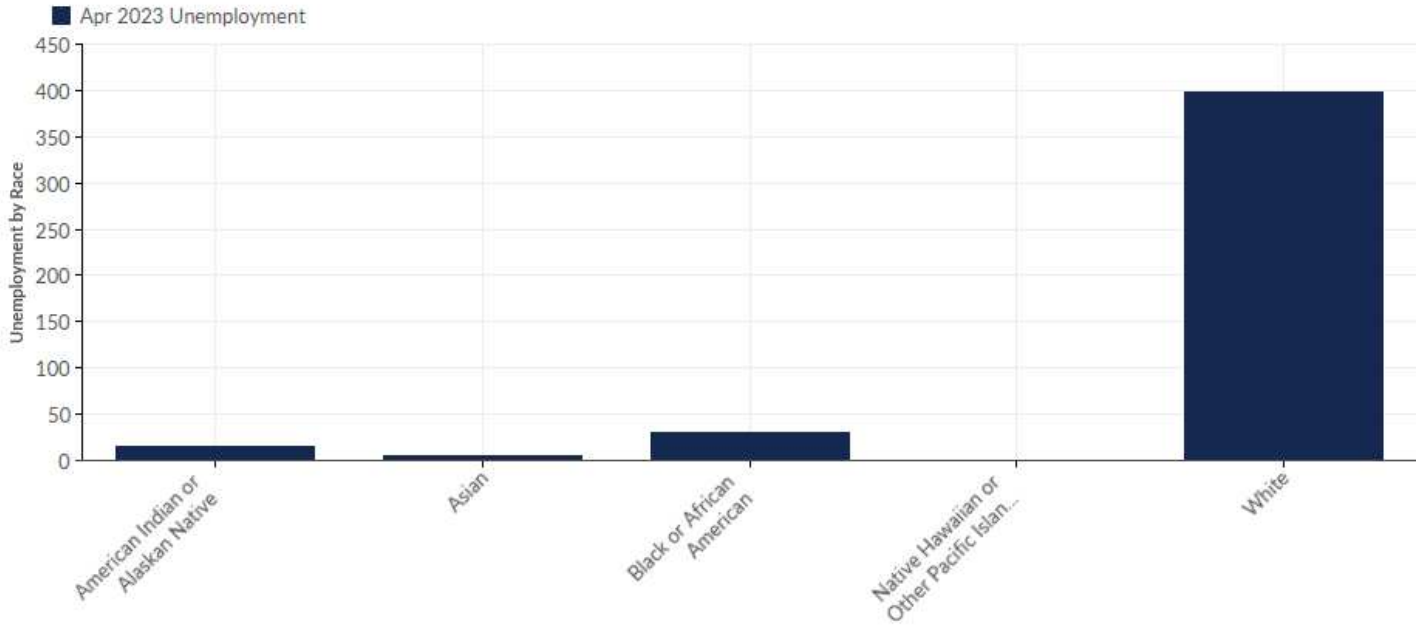

Unemployment by Gender



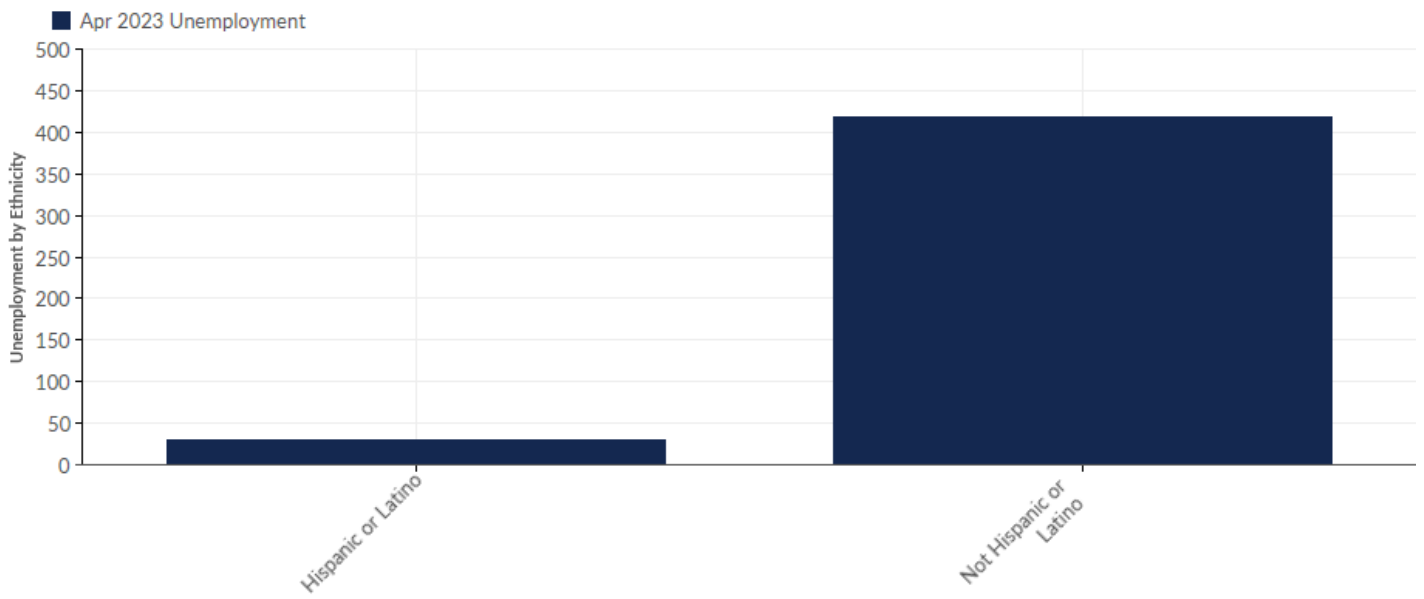

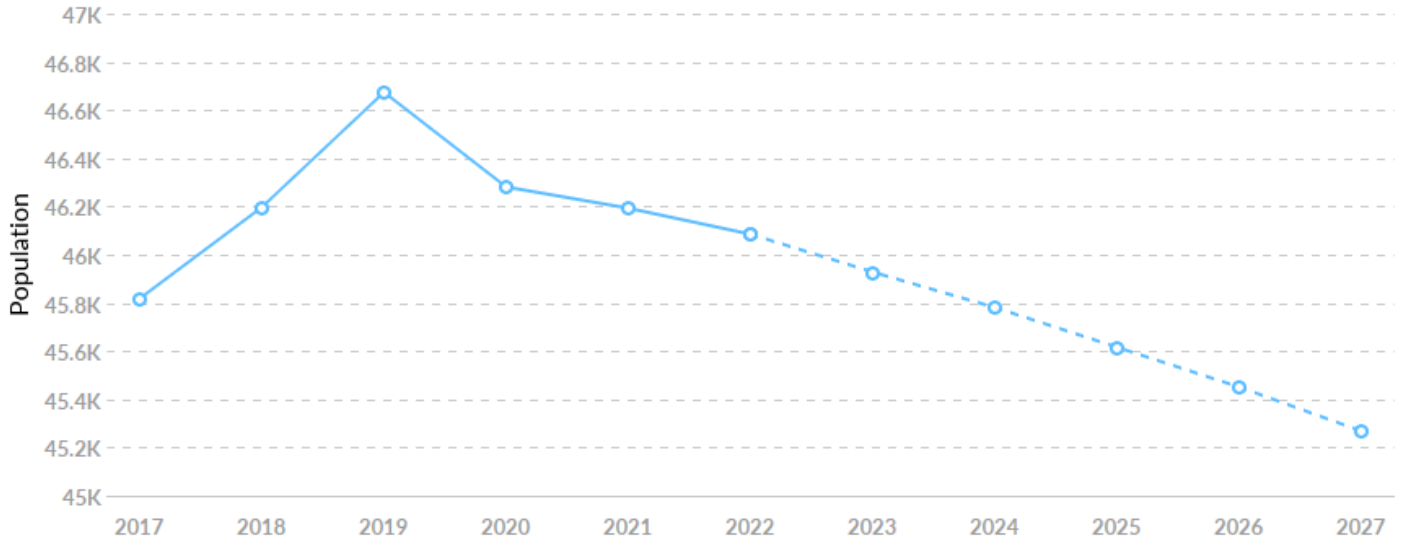

Population Trends

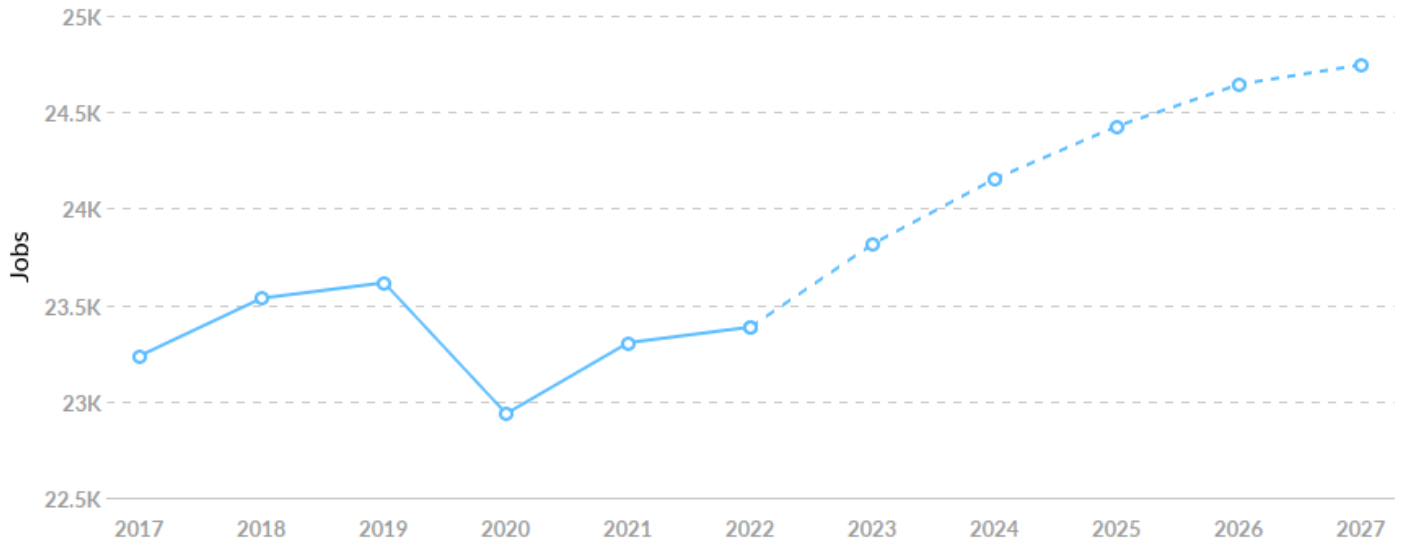
As of 2022 the region's population increased by 0.6% since 2017, growing by 267. Population is expected to decrease by 1.8% between 2022 and 2027, losing 817.

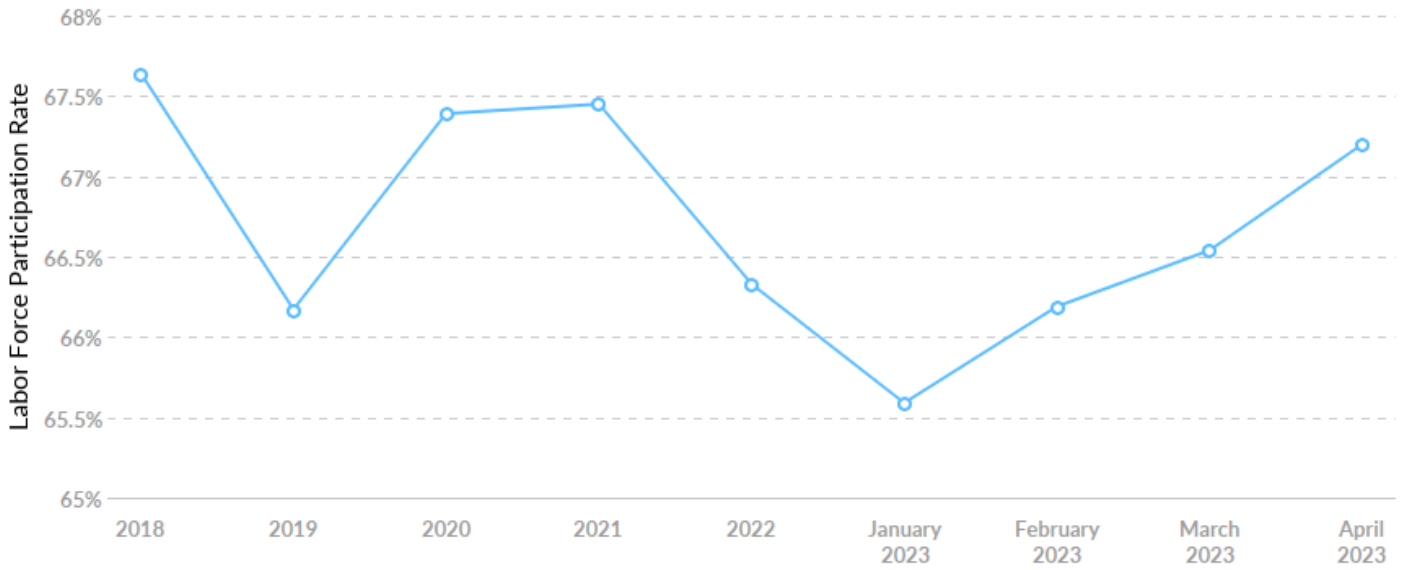
Job Trends

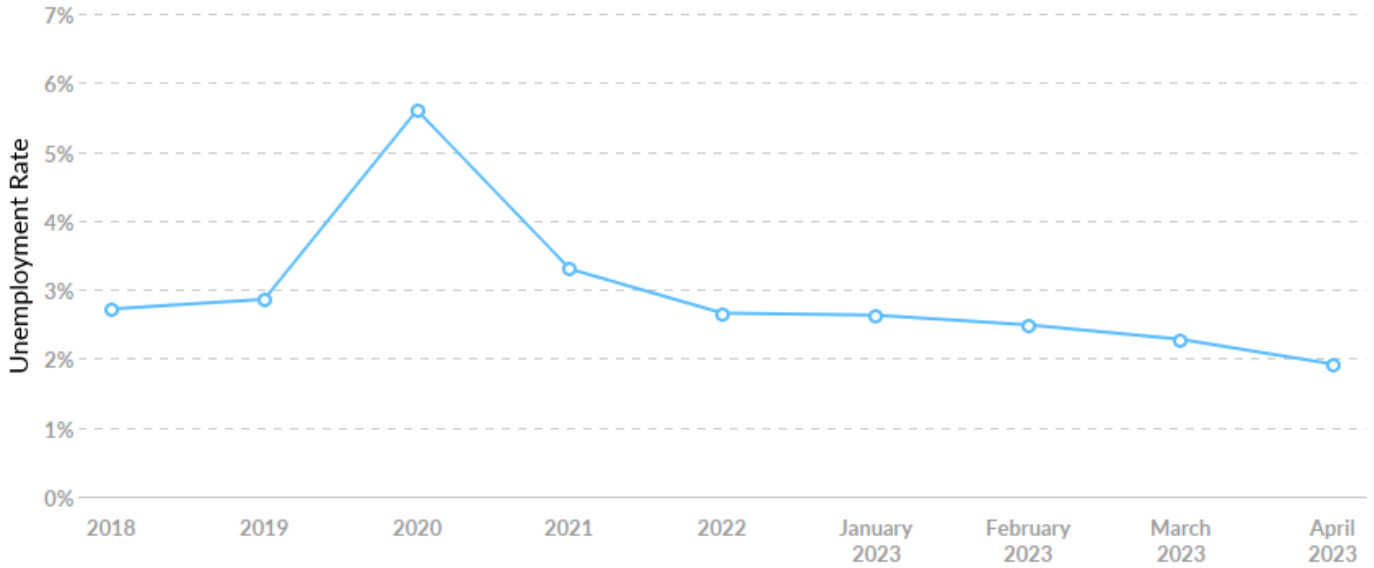

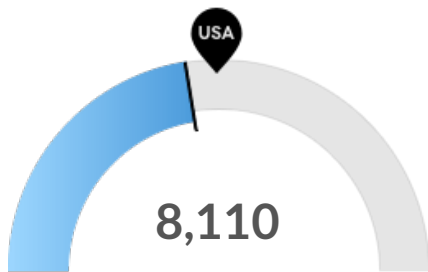
Unemployment Rate Trends

Monroe County, WI had an April 2023 unemployment rate of 1.92%, **decreasing from 2.72%** 5 years before.



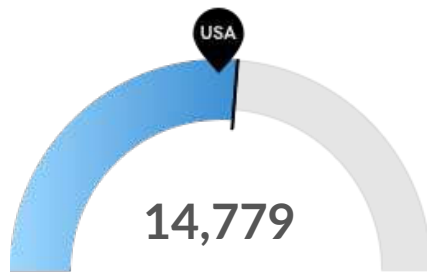

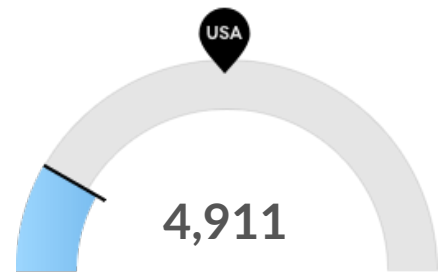
Millennials

Monroe County, WI has 8,110 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 9,436.



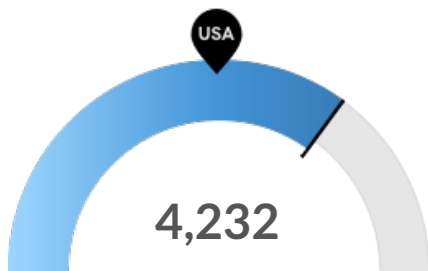
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is about average in Monroe County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 13,730 people 55 or older, while there are 14,779 here.



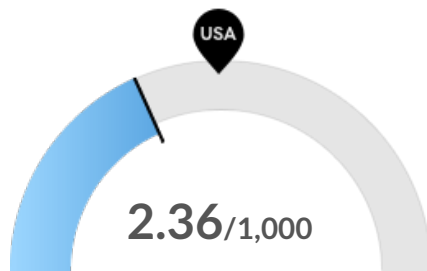
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Monroe County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 18,798 racially diverse people, while there are 4,911 here.



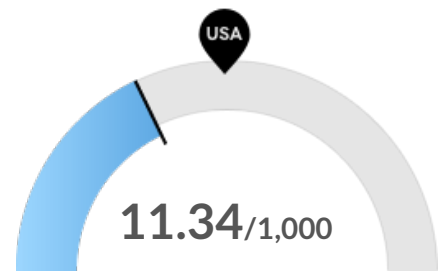
Veterans

Monroe County, WI has 2.36 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.59 per 1,000 people.

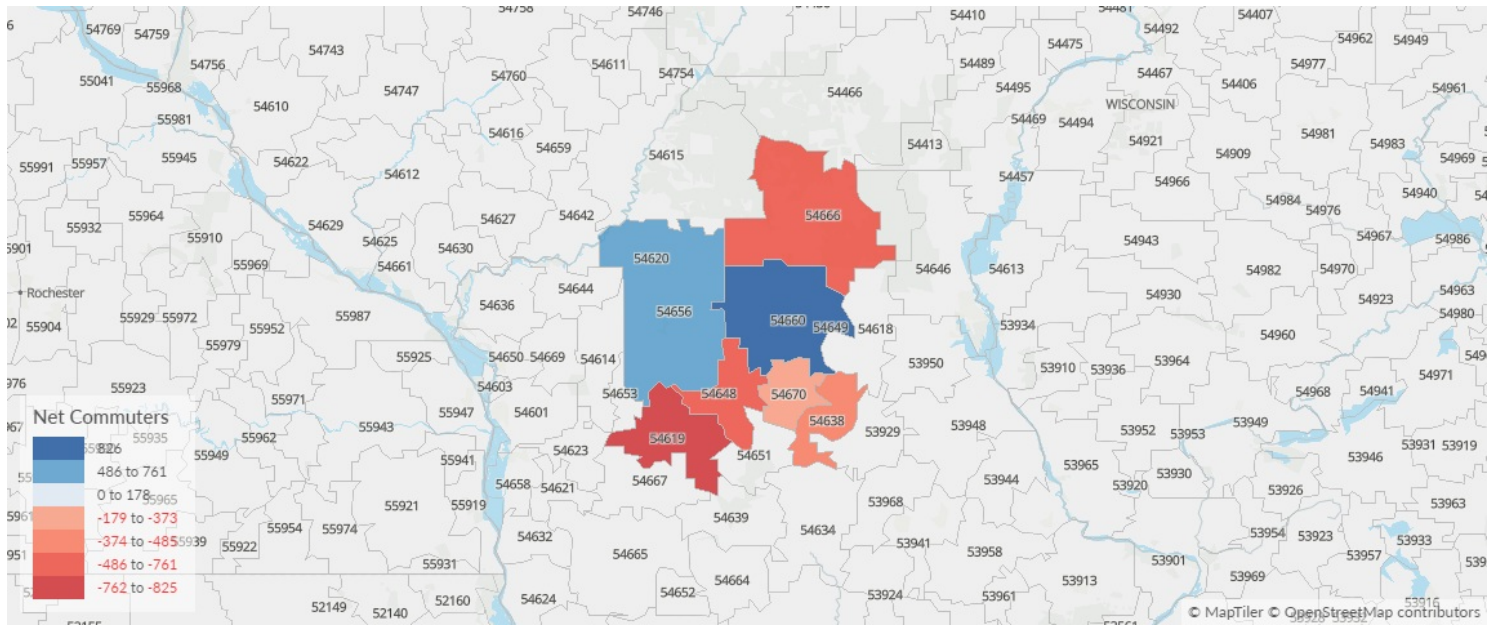


Property Crime

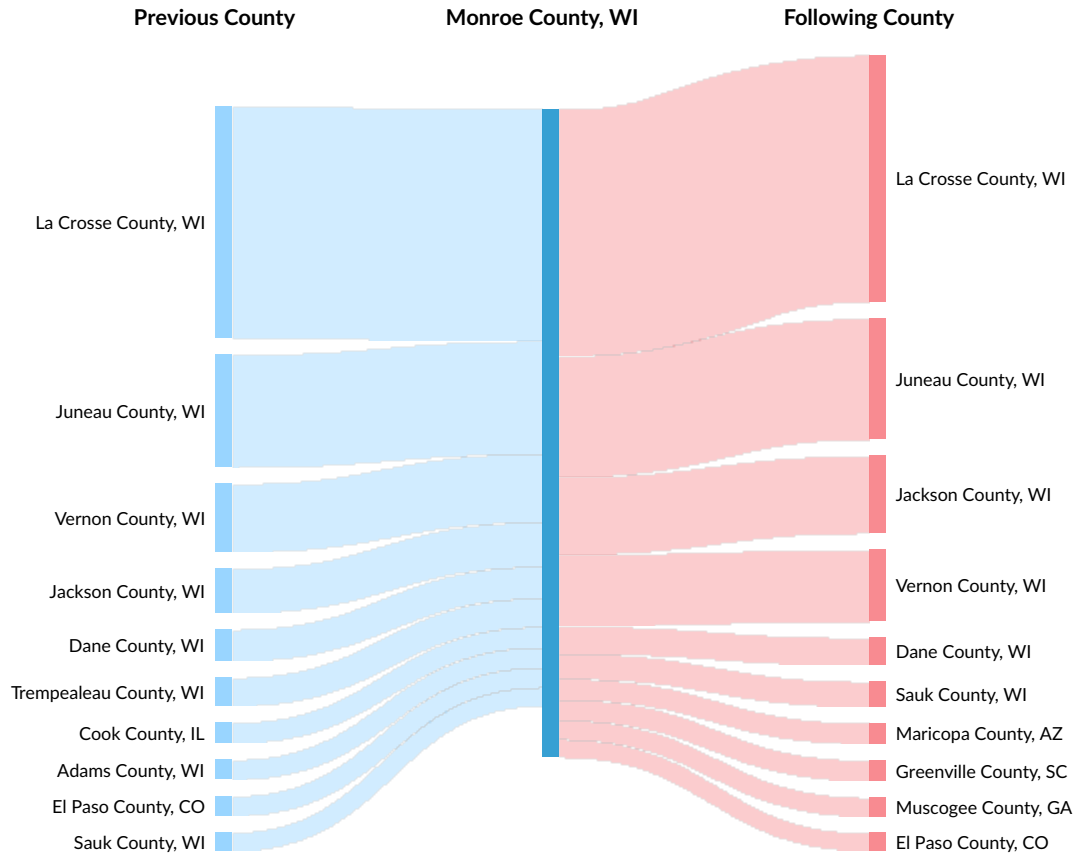

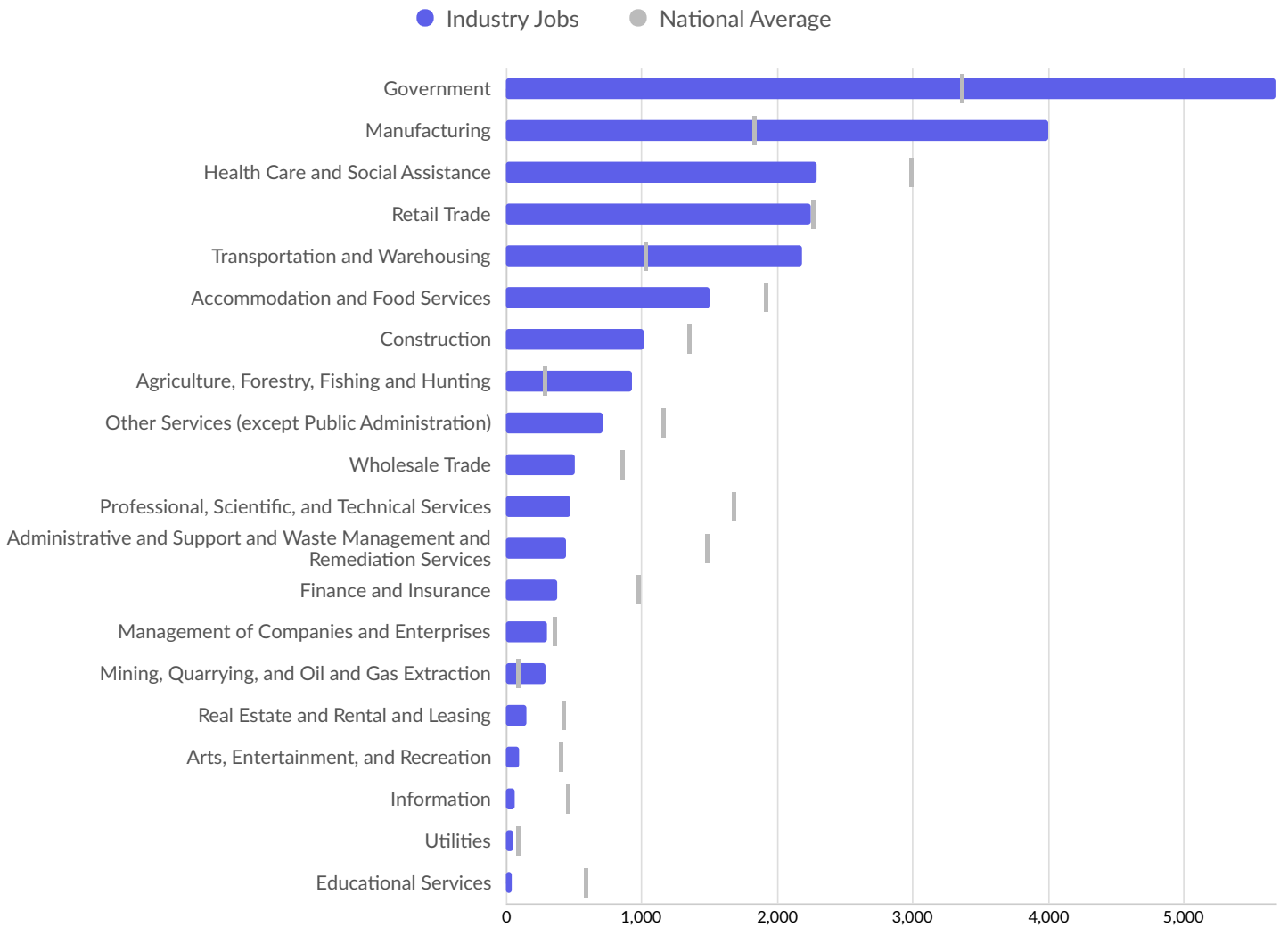

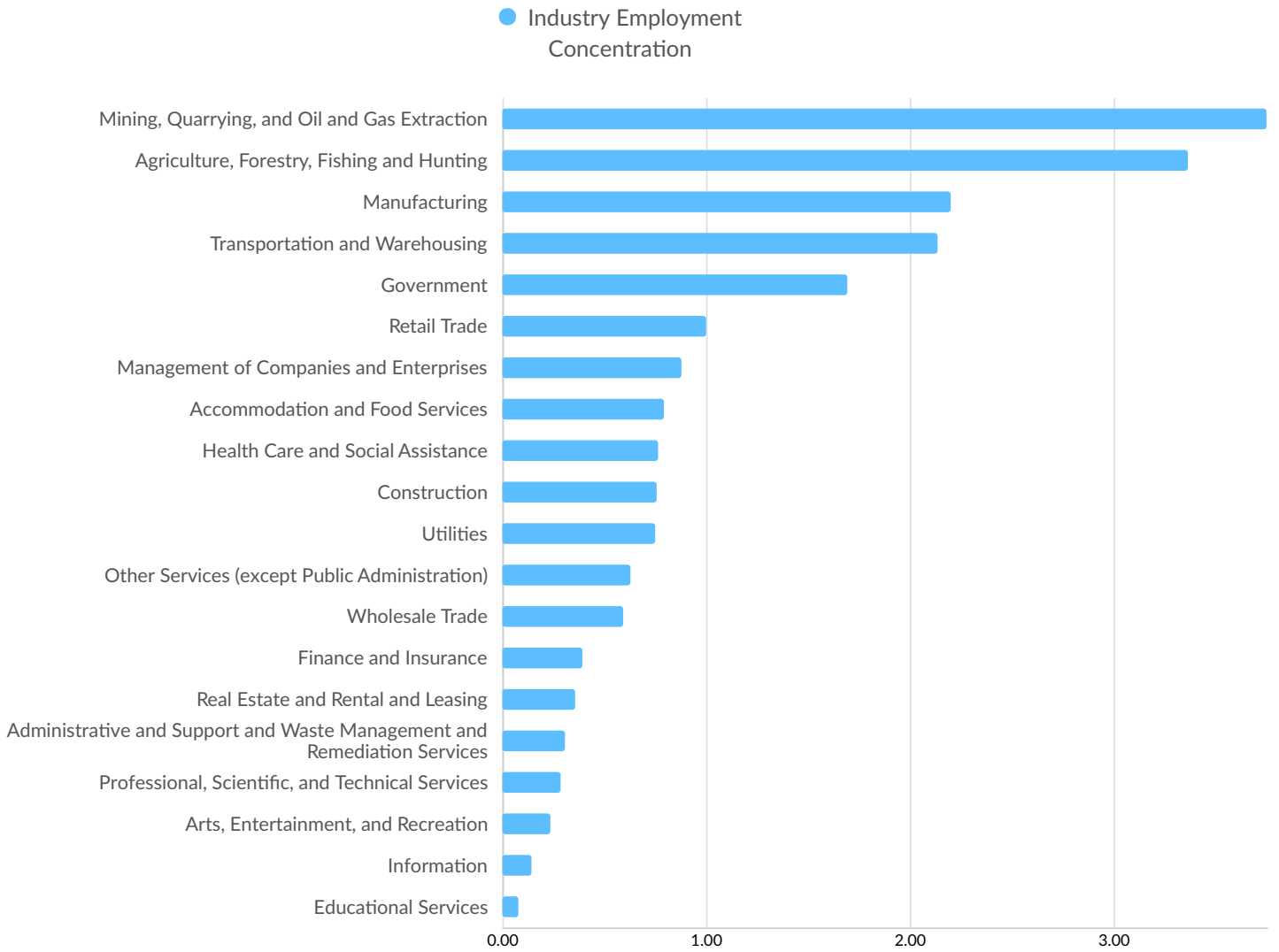

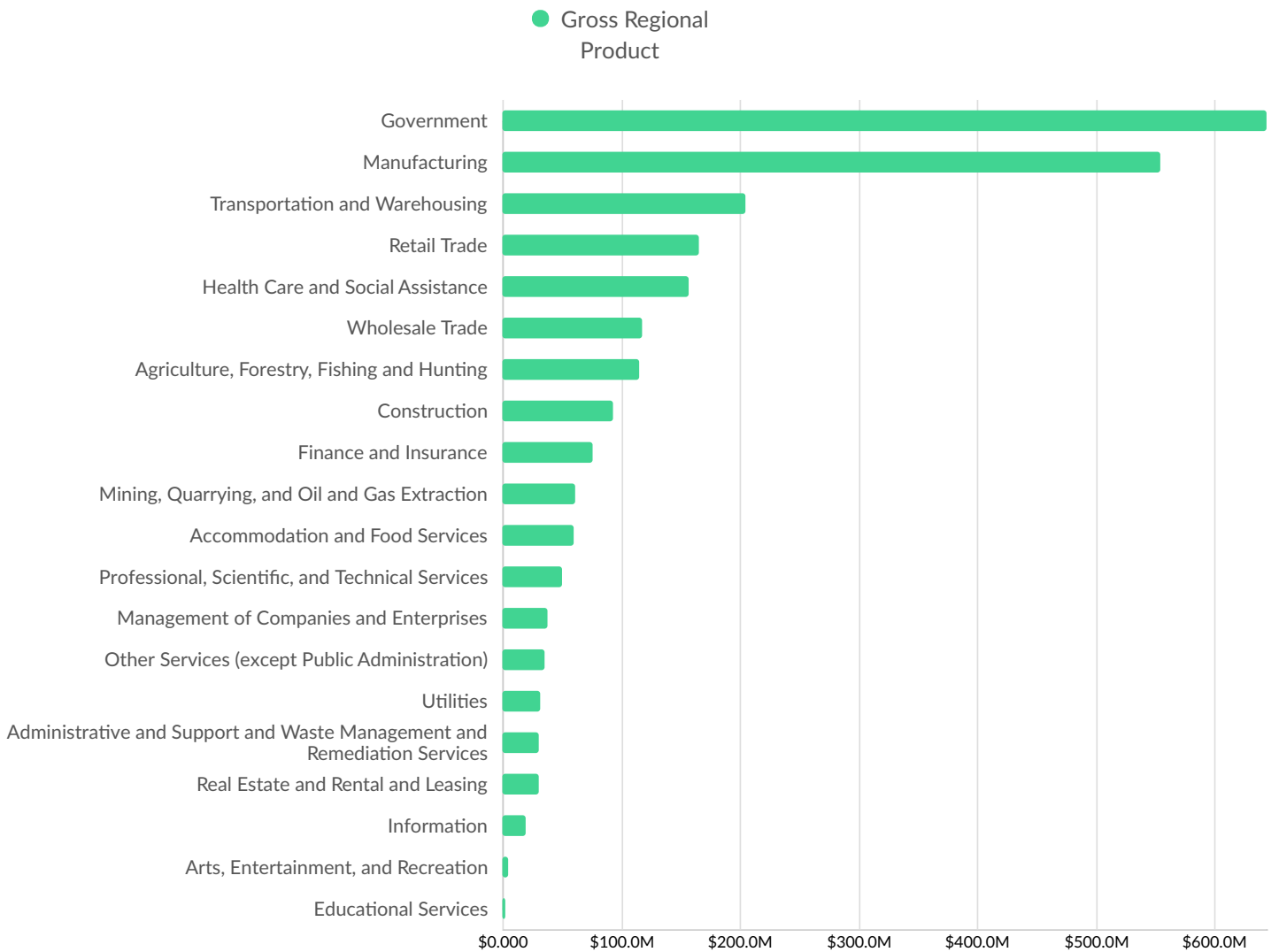
Top Growing Industries



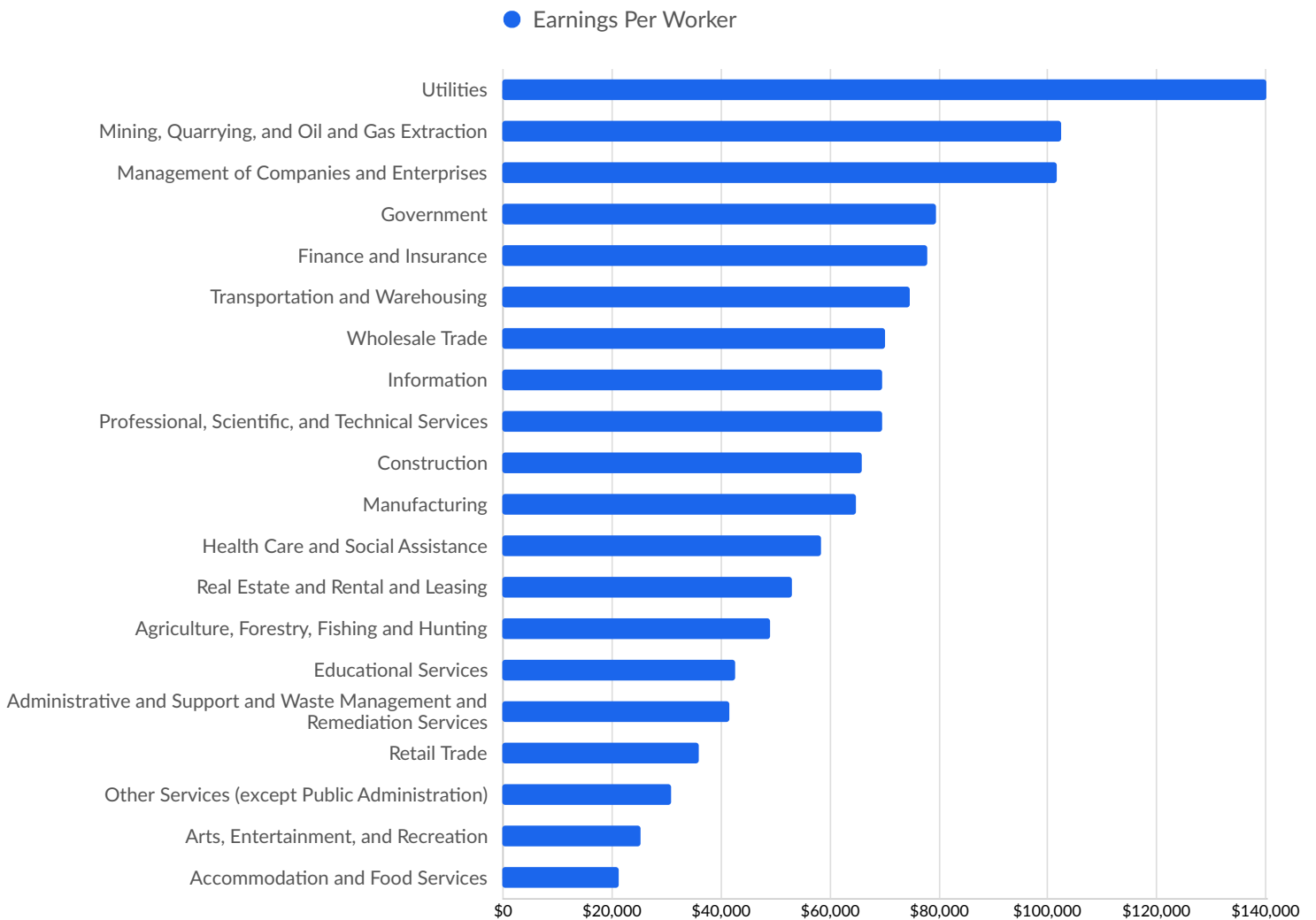
Top Industry Employment Concentration

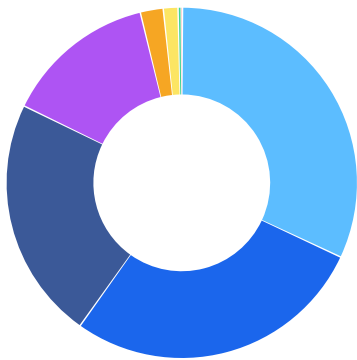

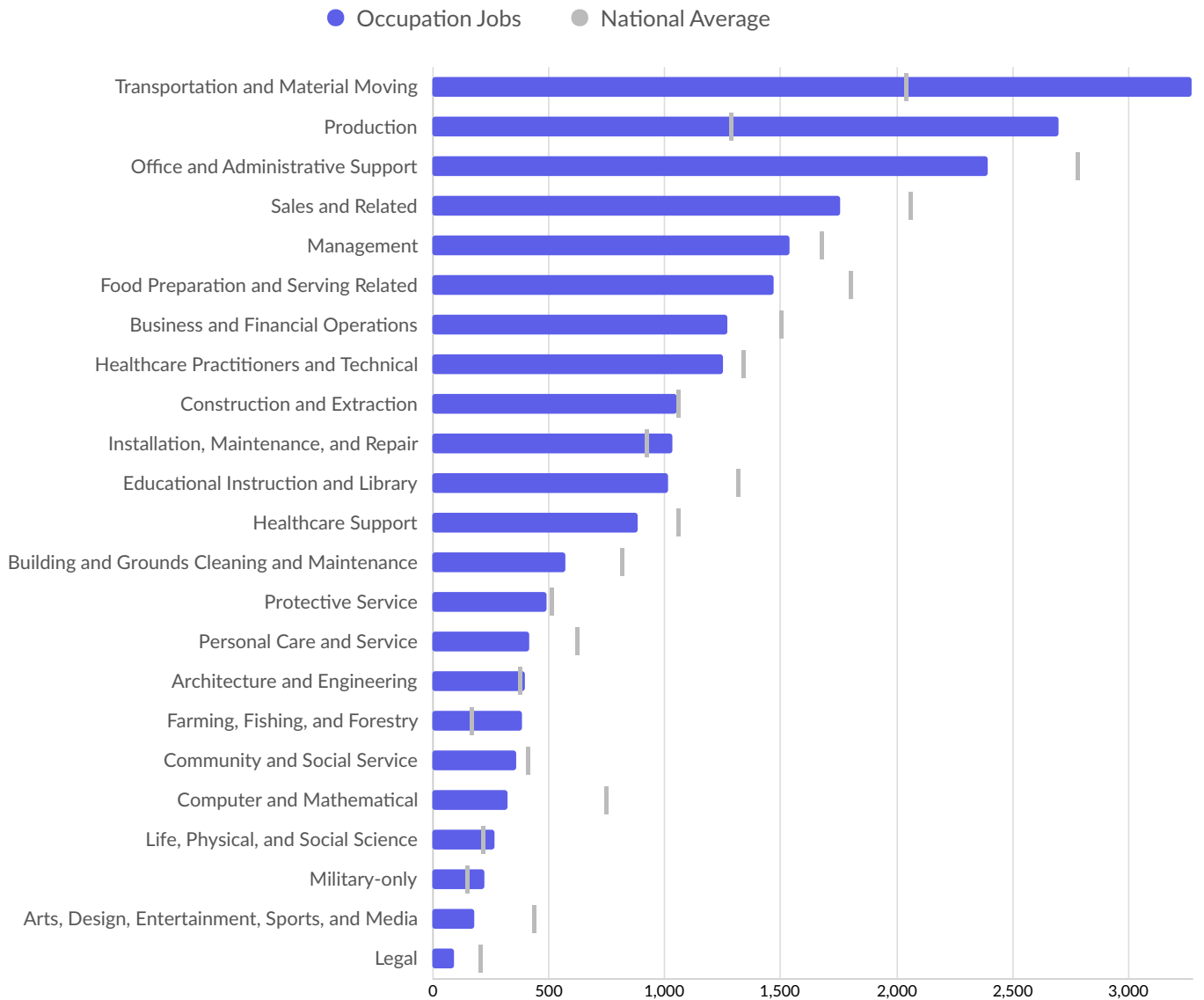

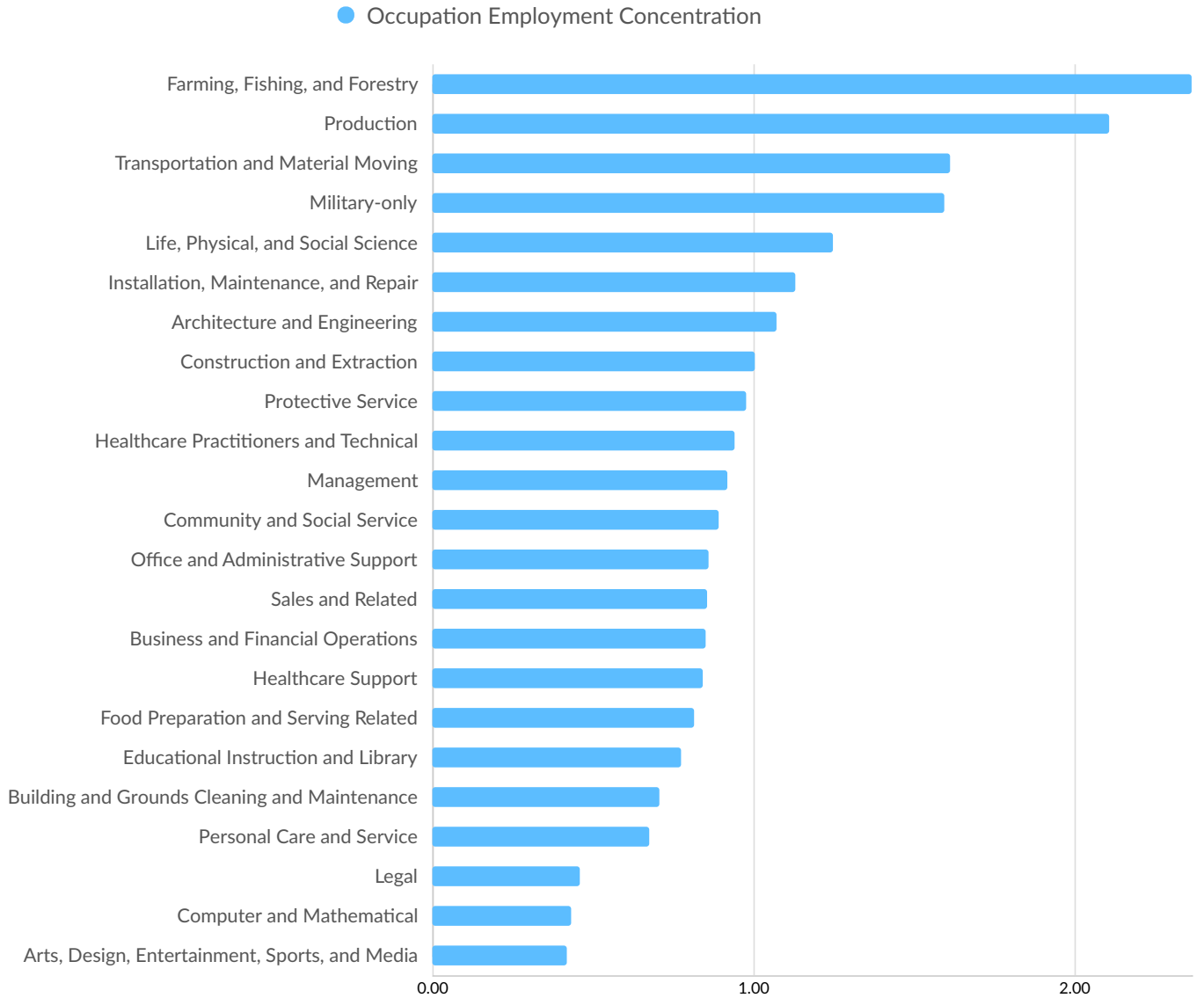

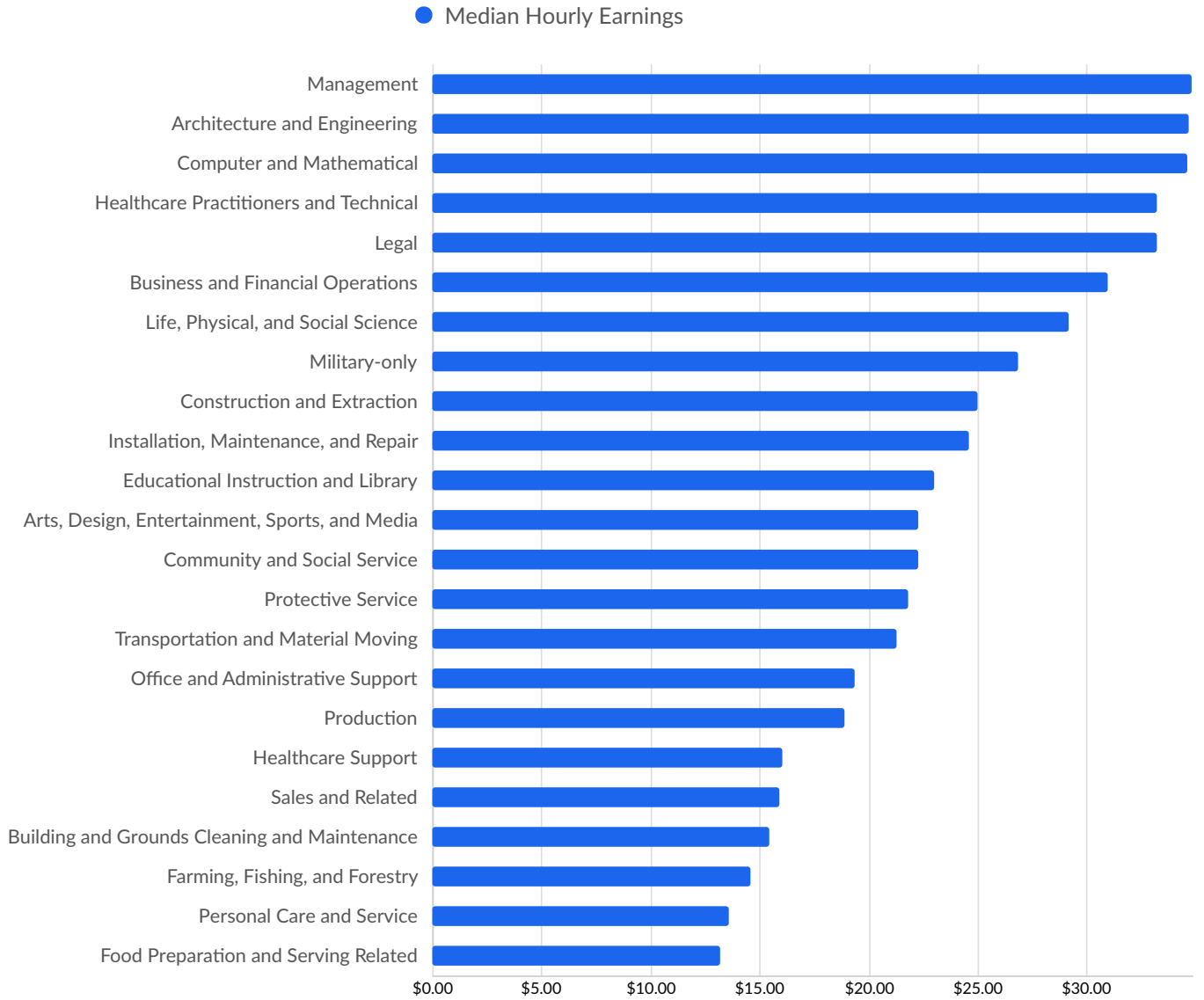
Top Growing Occupations



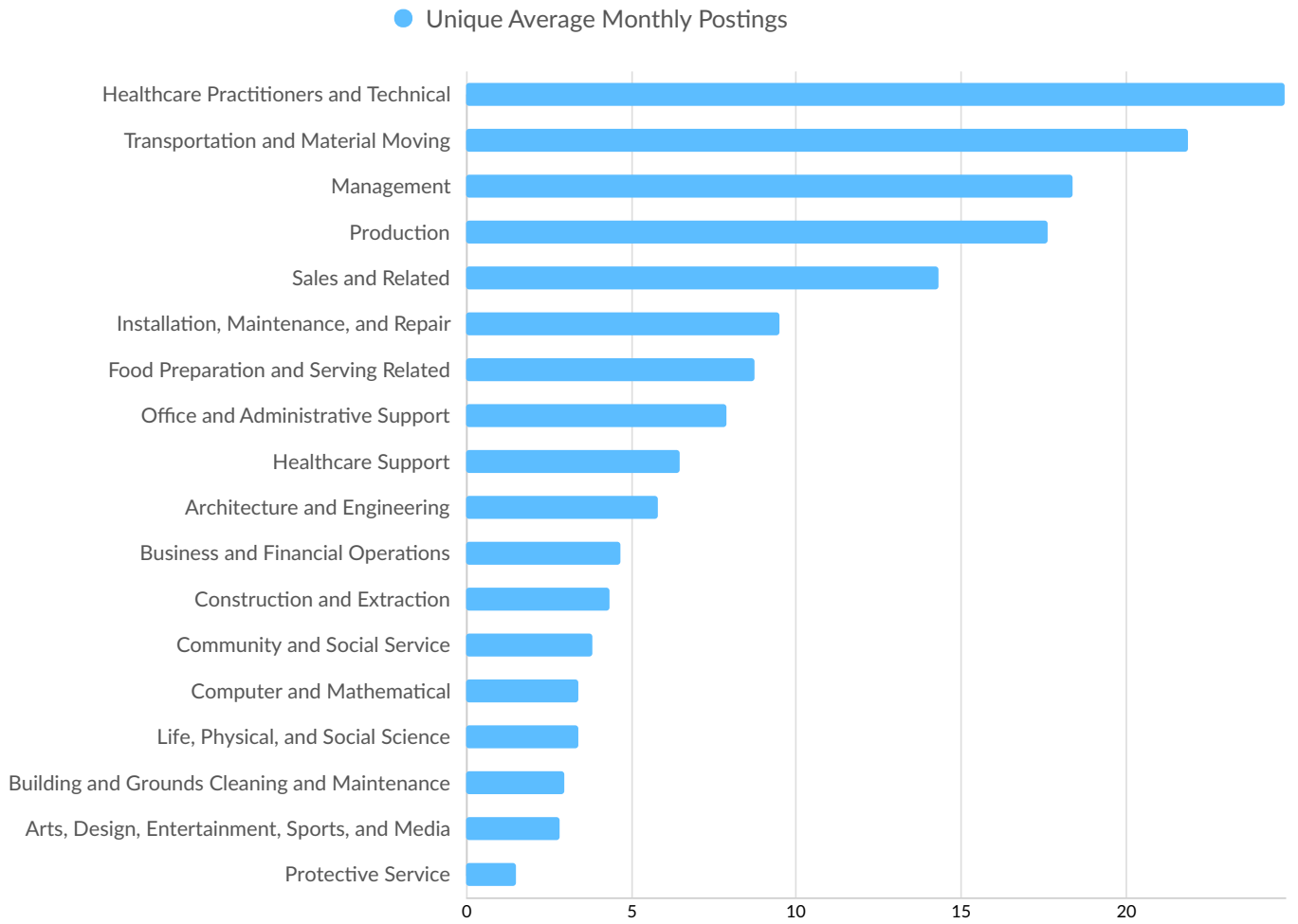
Top Occupation Employment Concentration



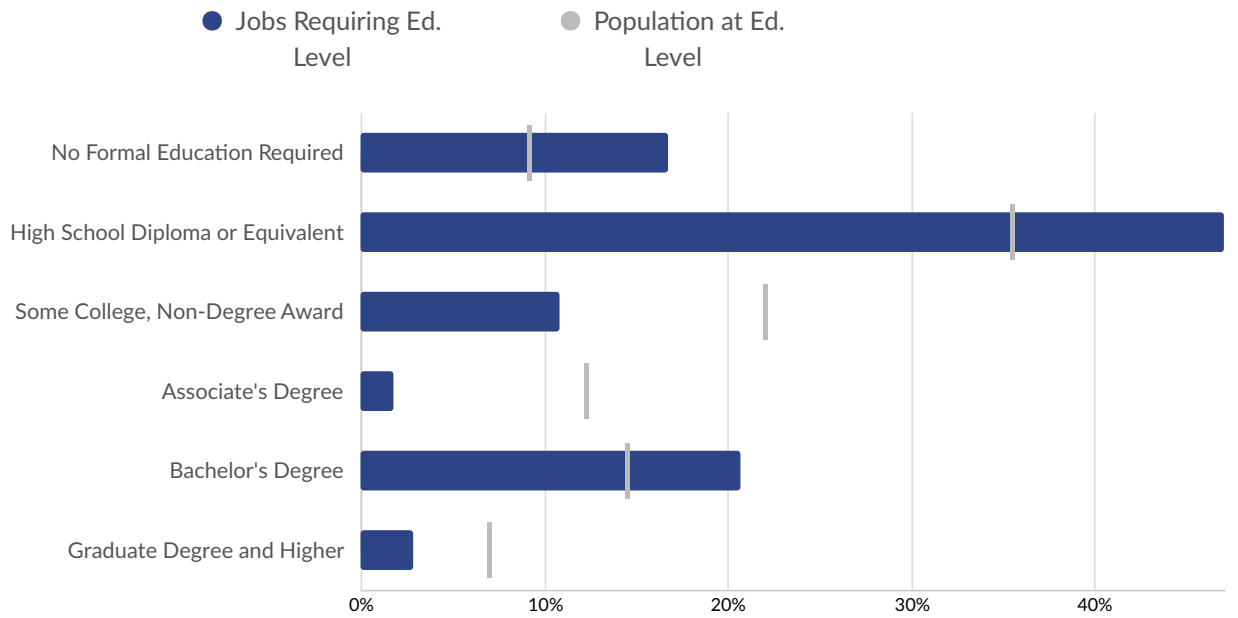
