#### **Takeaways**

- As of 2022 the region's population increased by 1.0% since 2017, growing by 322. Population is expected to increase by 1.2% between 2022 and 2027, adding 374.
- From 2017 to 2022, jobs declined by 2.8% in Vernon County, WI from 10,749 to 10,446. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.8% by 6.6%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 66.7% to 63.0% between 2017 and 2022.
- Concerning educational attainment, **16.1% of Vernon County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (4.7% below the national average), and **11.7% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.9% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2022 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, and Restaurants and Other Eating Places.




### Apr 2023 Labor Force Breakdown



#### **Educational Attainment**











As of 2022 the region's population increased by 1.0% since 2017, growing by 322. Population is expected to increase by 1.2% between 2022 and 2027, adding 374.



### **Job Trends**






Vernon County, WI had an April 2023 unemployment rate of 1.87%, decreasing from 2.85% 5 years before.




#### Millennials

Vernon County, WI has 1,577 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 1,624.




#### **Retiring Soon**

Retirement risk is high in Vernon County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 9,189 people 55 or older, while there are 10,940 here.




#### **Violent Crime**

Racial diversity is low in Vernon County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 12,581 racially diverse people, while there are 1,241 here.




#### **Property Crime**








### **Top Industry Employment Concentration**







### **Top Occupation Employment Concentration**









