- As of 2022 the region's population **increased by 1.1%** since 2017, growing by 331. Population is expected to **increase by 1.5%** between 2022 and 2027, adding 472.
- From 2017 to 2022, jobs declined by 2.5% in Vernon County, WI from 10,749 to 10,482. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.8% by 6.3%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 66.7% to 62.6% between 2017 and 2022.
- Concerning educational attainment, **16.0% of Vernon County**, **WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (4.8% below the national average), and **11.7% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.9% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2022 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, and Restaurants and Other Eating Places.







Unemployment by Gender





Unemployment by Ethnicity






Population Trends





Vernon County, WI had a September 2023 unemployment rate of 2.84%, decreasing from 2.85% 5 years before.






Population Characteristics

size is 6,316.




Retiring Soon

Racial diversity is low in Vernon County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 12,773 racially diverse people, while there are 1,279 here.




Veterans

Vernon County, WI has 0.23 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.59 per 1,000 people.




Property Crime










Top Industry Employment Concentration







Top Growing Occupations




Top Occupation Employment Concentration


Top Occupation Earnings



Median Hourly Earnings


