
### **Takeaways**

- As of 2023 the region's population increased by 3.0% since 2018, growing by 399. Population is expected to increase by 3.8% between 2023 and 2028, adding 509.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs declined by 0.6% in Buffalo County, WI from 4,589 to 4,560. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.9% by 4.5%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 61.8% to 52.5% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, **15.7% of Buffalo County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (5.5% below the national average), and **13.6% hold an Associate's Degree** (4.8% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are General Freight Trucking, Animal Production, and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).













### **Job Trends**






Buffalo County, WI had a February 2024 unemployment rate of 5.31%, increasing from 3.94% 5 years before.




#### Millennials

Buffalo County, WI has 2,108 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 2,723.




#### **Retiring Soon**

Retirement risk is high in Buffalo County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 4,013 people 55 or older, while there are 5.349 here.




#### **Racial Diversity**

Buffalo County, WI has 0.9 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.6 per 1,000 people.




#### **Property Crime**












### **Top Industry Employment Concentration**






### **Top Occupation Employment Concentration**










