
#### **Takeaways**

- As of 2023 the region's population declined by 1.0% since 2018, falling by 157. Population is expected to decrease by 0.3% between 2023 and 2028, losing 50.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs declined by 9.8% in Crawford County, WI from 8,326 to 7,511. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.9% by 13.7%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 62.1% to 53.3% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, **13.0% of Crawford County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (8.1% below the national average), and **12.7% hold an Associate's Degree** (3.9% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Other Nonmetallic Mineral Product Manufacturing.













### **Job Trends**






Crawford County, WI had a February 2024 unemployment rate of 5.44%, increasing from 4.02% 5 years before.




### Millennials

Crawford County, WI has 2,454 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 3,255.




#### **Veterans**

Retirement risk is high in Crawford County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 4,797 people 55 or older, while there are 6,574 here.




#### **Violent Crime**

Racial diversity is low in Crawford County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 6,583 racially diverse people, while there are 956 here.




#### **Property Crime**










### **Top Industry Employment Concentration**












