
#### **Takeaways**

- As of 2023 the region's population increased by 6.6% since 2018, growing by 1,937. Population is expected to increase by 7.0% between 2023 and 2028, adding 2,207.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs declined by 9.4% in Trempealeau County, WI from 15,963 to 14,464. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.9% by 13.3%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 73.0% to 60.3% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, **13.8% of Trempealeau County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (7.4% below the national average), and **15.8% hold an Associate's Degree** (7.0% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Household and Institutional Furniture and Kitchen Cabinet Manufacturing, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.






### **Unemployment by Gender**



### **Unemployment by Ethnicity**







#### **Job Trends**






Trempealeau County, WI had a February 2024 unemployment rate of 4.53%, increasing from 3.42% 5 years before.







#### **Veterans**

Trempealeau County, WI has 1,741 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 1.616.




#### **Retiring Soon**

Retirement risk is high in Trempealeau County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 9,260 people 55 or older, while there are 10,399 here.




#### **Violent Crime**

Racial diversity is low in Trempealeau County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 12,707 racially diverse people, while there are 3,690 here.




#### **Property Crime**








### **Top Industry Employment Concentration**






